## Notes.

- 2. There is one informal review period and two formal review periods of at least 8 weeks. Comments from all reviews will be collated by the TSU and passed to the chapter CLAs. Comments received in the two formal reviews and the responses by the author teams to them need to be recorded and archived by the TSU.
