**SUBJECT:** Federal Wage System Employees in Alaska

The Office of Personnel Management has requested certain information regarding the compensation of Federal Wage System (FWS) employees in Alaska for use in developing uniform pay practices for all prevailing rate employees in Alaska.

The following information should be provided for each installation or location in Alaska where FWS employees are stationed:

- o Name of installation or location, with the applicable location code in the General Services Administration's Worldwide Geographic Location Codes, dated June 1981;
- o Identification of regular or special differential schedule from which employees are compensated; and
- o Number of FWS employees by title, series, and grade.

This information should be received in the Personnel Policy Division, M-16, by January 25, 1985. Negative replies are requested. Questions concerning the study may be directed to Mr. Mark Meza on 426-4135.
