

Private Remote Sensing System License Public Summary

On September 29, 2003, the National Environmental Satellite, Data and Information Service of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, an agency of the U.S. Department of Commerce, issued or otherwise granted a License (the "License") to:

to operate a private, commercial, space-based, remote sensing system named WorldView (formerly known as D-4), consisting of four satellites.

The WorldView satellites, low-earth orbit electro-optical imaging satellite systems, are designed to collect 0.25 meter resolution panchromatic imagery at between 450 and 850 kilometer altitudes with approximately 97.8 degree orbital location and sun synchronous inclination. The launch of the first WorldView satellite is currently scheduled for mid-2007.
