Any objection to the Disclosure Statement must be filed with the Court and served on the debtor or the proponent of the Plan (if not the debtor) and all entities described in L.R. 3017 C (L.B.R. 3017-1 C for cases filed before June 5, 2008). **Objections must be filed on or before _____.** (*Insert date that is five (5) calendar days prior to the hearing date for cases filed before June 5, 2008; five (5) business days prior to the hearing date for cases filed on or after June 5, 2008.*)

The objection shall identify those portions of the disclosure statement which the objecting party asserts are incomplete, misleading, erroneous, or are otherwise the basis for the objection

and shall state in detail, the information sought to be added or deleted from the Disclosure Statement. Where appropriate, the objector shall propose acceptable language which the objector requests be included in the disclosure statement.

The Disclosure Statement must be approved by the Bankruptcy Court before the Plan may be submitted to the creditors for a vote. A copy of the Plan, Approved Disclosure Statement and Notice of Hearing on Confirmation of the Plan will be sent to all parties in interest at a later date.
