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
## Evaluation of the DoD Safety Program Background

May 2003: SecDef issued a challenge to reduce accidents & mishaps by 50%.

March 2004: SecDef increased the challenge to reduce accidents and mishaps by 75% by 2008.

August 2004: DUSD(R) requested comprehensive, systemic safety program evaluation.

November 2004: DIG(IP) signed the letter announcing the evaluation of the DoD Safety Program.





# Evaluation of the DoD Safety Program Objectives & Elements

### **Objectives**

- Evaluate the DOD <u>safety program</u> and suggest changes to help achieve a <u>reduction in accidents</u>, as directed by the SecDef.
- Identify <u>safety issues</u> within DoD and provide a <u>roadmap for change</u> to improve the Department's safety program.

#### **Elements**

Safety Culture (Safety Perception Surveys)

I - Senior Leader III - Civilian

II - Active Duty IV - Guard/Reserve

- Resourcing
- Organization
- Exceptional Practices



# Evaluation of the DoD Safety Program Recommendations for Improvement

Change the Mindset: Provide vision of safety transformation.

Action: SecDef

Build Accountability: Unify OSD efforts and fully engage COCOMs.

Action: DepSecDef

<u>Transform the Program</u>: Define expectations through a safety management system.

Action: USD (AT&L)

Measure Progress: Report biennial survey results to the SecDef.

Action: USD (AT&L)



# Evaluation of the DoD Safety Program Continuing Impacts

- OIG conducted and widely disseminated the first DoD-wide benchmarked safety climate survey.
- OSD and the Services agreed with identified leadership gap.
- The SAF directed the development of leading safety metrics.
- Army & Defense Logistics Agency implemented OIG developed survey.
- Commander, Naval Safety Center requested a coordination meeting with the SAF/IE.
- OSD updated DoD Dir 4715.1E (ESOH).
- SecDef directed COCOMs to actively engage in safety.
- USD(P&R) requested the OIG reassess the DoD safety climate.
- USD(P&R) requested "the Way Forward."
- USD(AT&L) concurred with, and is acting on OIG "Way Forward."
