ORDER REGARDING INTEREST-BEARING REGISTRY FUNDS

All judicial orders directing deposit of funds into the interest-bearing registry of the court shall include either the social security or tax identification number(s) of each recipient, if known at the time. If the recipient(s) are not known at the time, the social security or tax identification number(s) must be included in the order directing disbursement of interest-bearing registry funds. This information is required for processing IRS 1099 interest forms beginning January 1, 1994. The clerk's office prepares these tax forms for recipients of registry funds earning \$10 or more of interest per year.
