General Order Adopting U.S. Probation Office Corrective, Disciplinary and Adverse Action Policy and the Workplace Drug Testing Program

The U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Texas hereby adopts the Corrective, Disciplinary and Adverse Action Policy and the Workplace Drug Testing Program for Probation Officers and Officer Assistants. These policies will be contained in the probation office's Policy Manual, administrative section. The administrative policies and procedures for the probation office were previously adopted by the Court in General Order No. 98-3. The Corrective, Disciplinary and Adverse Action policy referenced in this order supercedes the Adverse Action Policy approved in General Order No. 98-3. All other administrative policies and procedures approved in General Order No. 98-3 remain in effect.
