

Results of the Q3 2008 American E-Government Satisfaction Index

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The Big Picture



Summary of Findings

- Citizen satisfaction with E-Gov has increased two quarters in a row
 - Aggregate satisfaction: 73.9
 - Up 1.4% (one full point) quarter-over-quarter and up 0.6 points year-over-year
 - Index has not achieved this level since Q4 2006
 - Approaches all-time high score of 74.0 (Q2 2006)
- Is the increase real?
 - 98 sites measured in Q3 2008
 - In spite of Index composition shifts, score increase is <u>still present</u> if we compare only participants in both Q2 and Q3 (95 sites)
- More sites than ever are "top performers"
 - 27% of sites are "top performers" (26 sites) up from 21% (23 sites) previously
 - Scores of 80 or higher becoming more widespread
- Citizens are most satisfied with E-Commerce/Transaction sites
 - Satisfaction is 78.2 in Q3 2008
 - In addition to being the highest category score, it has increased for three consecutive quarters
 - Up 1.6% (1.2 points) compared to 2Q




Citizens and Their Future Behavior

Highly-satisfied citizens (individual site visitors scoring E-Gov sites 80 or higher) are significantly more likely than dissatisfied citizens (scoring less than 70) to exhibit desired future behaviors.

A satisfied site visitor is:

- 84% more likely to use the site as a primary resource
- 85% more likely to recommend the site to others
- 58% more likely to return to the site






□ Dissatisfied Site Visitors (<70) □ Satisfied Site Visitors (80+)

ACSI E-Gov Index Quarterly Trend Line 2003-2008




ACSI E-Gov Index Quarterly Trend Lines by Functional Category, 2006-2008


ACSI E-Gov Index Quarterly Trend Lines by Organizational Category, 2006-2008




Trend: Satisfaction and Future Behaviors
