Specific Incident: The manufacturer issued an "Important Safety Notice" on February

10, 2003, (attached) to remind users that the <u>auxiliary water</u> channel must be reprocessed each time the endoscope is used.

Recommendations: 1. Follow manufacturer instructions.

2. All channels of all endoscopes must be reprocessed during

each reprocessing cycle even if the channels were not utilized

during the preceding patient procedure.
