Item 52: Public Hearing – Zoning Case Z034-245 (WE) – UNDER ADVISEMENT - INDIVIDUAL

A public hearing was called on zoning case Z034-245 (WE), an application for a Planned Development District for mixed uses and the termination of a portion of SUP No. 187 for a cemetery and mortuary use and a private recreation club or area for a golf driving range on property zoned an R-7.5(A) Single Family District with Specific Use Permit No. 187 on the north side of Camp Wisdom Road, east of Manitoba Avenue with consideration given to an MF-1(A) Multifamily District.)

(The city plan commission recommended approval of a Planned Development District for mixed uses, subject to a revised conceptual plan, development plan and revised conditions and approval of the termination of a portion of SUP No. 187 This item was considered by the City Council at a public hearing on September 22, 2004, and was taken under advisement until October 13, 2004, with the public hearing open.)

Councilmember Fantroy announced that he had a conflict of interest and would abstain from voting or participating in any discussion. Councilmember Fantroy left the city council chamber.

No one appeared in opposition to or in favor of the city plan commission's recommendation.

Deputy Mayor Pro Tem Hill moved to postpone the application until the October 27, 2004 voting agenda meeting of the city council and to continue the public hearing at that time.

Motion seconded by Councilmember Griffith and unanimously adopted. (Fantroy abstain; Loza, Finkelman absent on city business)
