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2 The following is a transcript of a telephone
3 conversation between DARREN REAGAN, ALLEN MCGILL and
4 GAIL TERRELL on March 7, 2005.
5 (UI) UNINTELLIGIBLE
6 (PH) PHONETIC
7 (Phone Ringing)
8 GAIL TERRELL (TERRELL): Hello.
9 DARREN REAGAN (REAGAN): Hey, sister.
10 TERRELL: Hey, brother.
11 REAGAN: Hey, brother still around?
12 TERRELL: Yeah, hold a minute.
13 REAGAN: Okay.
14 ALLEN MCGILL (MCGILL): Hello. Hello.
15 REAGAN: Hey, man.
16 MCGILL: Hey.
17 REAGAN: Yeah, he had called, I guess, while we were
18 on the phone, three way, and went into my voice mail
19 saying he's gonna be about 20 minutes late. He's
20 waiting on the girl, she's in the parking lot now.
21 MCGILL: (Laughing)
22 REAGAN: Ahh, with, with the certified check.
23 MCGILL: Well, sounds like you making...
24 REAGAN: Well.
25 MCGILL: ...a little progress there.

1 REAGAN: Well, he gonna, I already know he gonna come
2 in here poor mouthing.
3 MCGILL: Of course.
4 REAGAN: 'Cause he, 'cause he ain't gonna come, he
5 ain't gonna come in (cough) with, with ahh, well,
6 hell, he hadn't, he hadn't kept his commitment to date
7 on any of this shit, so.
8 MCGILL: Well, he's gonna come in poor mouthing, but
9 all of that, he ain't gonna have all the contracts either.
10 REAGAN: Oh, no.
11 MCGILL: Uh-huh.
12 REAGAN: Oh, no, and I sent him a note saying, let's,
13 let's bring all that together.
14 MCGILL: Mm-hmmm. But he ain't gonna do that.
15 REAGAN: Naw, uh-huh.
16 MCGILL: No, he's gonna bring...
17 REAGAN: Uh-huh.
18 MCGILL: ...the other thing, thinking that, that'll
19 hold it off for a while.
20 REAGAN: Well.
21 (Pause)
22 REAGAN: It is gonna hold it off.
23 MCGILL: (Laughing) Yeah.
24 REAGAN: It's gonna, it's off the table.
25 MCGILL: (Laughing) Yeah. Well, that'll give him

1 plenty more time. Obviously, he still hasn't had
2 enough time.

3 REAGAN: DON took that money, man, and went and gave
4 it to that open government, man.

5 MCGILL: Brother, brother, it hurt my heart that he
6 would think so little of his own staff. That's the
7 first thing I thought of. I said, now why wouldn't
8 that brother, and he's in a legitimate campaign race.
9 Why wouldn't that brother just enhance his staff.

10 REAGAN: Well, he, he, he, he knew that BILL and them
11 was gonna give some more money, I was gonna bring it
12 to him, that's all.

13 MCGILL: Well, I guess so, and he...

14 REAGAN: And, and, that, and...

15 MCGILL: ...thinks that's the way to impress the
16 white folks downtown.

17 REAGAN: Oh, yeah, that's, I'm telling you what he
18 did, brother. Exactly what he did. He took that
19 money, and went over there, and no sooner I put it in
20 his hand, he went, he halfin', and instead of halving it
21 up to, ahh, with, with that boy...

22 MCGILL: Mm-hmmm.

23 REAGAN: He took it to the white people. He took a
24 half to the white people, kept the other half to himself.

25 MCGILL: Man, please.

1 REAGAN: Now, I'm gonna do, I'm gonna handle this one
2 a little differently, 'cause I'm gonna, I'm gonna
3 break some off for D'ANGELO. And, ahh, I'm gonna give
4 some to DON.
5 (Pause)
6 REAGAN: It'll be, it, it's gonna be, it'd be hard
7 pressed to get D'ANGELO signed on. I, I thought about
8 that too.
9 MCGILL: Yeah, but...
10 REAGAN: (UI)
11 MCGILL: ...he says that he feels like he ain't
12 getting, getting his due.
13 REAGAN: Yeah, get, getting D'ANGELO really motivated...
14 MCGILL: Mm-hmmm, and keep, and stay motivated, and
15 stay holding the line.
16 REAGAN: (UI), yeah, 'cause, 'cause he don't, he
17 ain't seeing, look, I had to handle that first one
18 like that though.
19 MCGILL: Mm-hmmm.
20 REAGAN: Had to.
21 MCGILL: Well, if DON...
22 REAGAN: To keep, to keep...
23 MCGILL: ...handle, it's DON's call from then on.
24 REAGAN: Mm-hmmm.
25 MCGILL: Ahh, and, and ahh, clearly D'ANGELO saw that

1 that was DON's call.

2 REAGAN: Yeah.

3 MCGILL: You know? So, but I think you're absolutely

4 right. The last thing in the world you want is that

5 nigger going sideways. Thinking...

6 REAGAN: Yeah.

7 MCGILL: ...that he's got to cut a better deal direct.

8 REAGAN: Mm-hmmm.

9 MCGILL: Yeah.

10 REAGAN: Yeah. But...

11 (Pause)

12 MCGILL: Yeah, man, I was stunned to hear that, hear

13 him say that. I couldn't believe it actually.

14 REAGAN: (UI).

15 MCGILL: I said, damn.

16 REAGAN: Well.

17 MCGILL: (UI)

18 REAGAN: I told BILL, I said, I'm gonna, I'm gonna go

19 on and have lunch on you.

20 MCGILL: (Laughing)

21 REAGAN: 'Cause y'all had all morning to get this

22 shit straightened out.

23 MCGILL: (Laughing)

24 REAGAN: Certainly after I told y'all to get it done...

25 MCGILL: (Laughing)

1 REAGAN: ...the other day.

2 MCGILL: (Laughing) Yeah. He must have been happy to
3 hear that. (Laughing) And who knows, it may not take
4 20 minutes after all. (Laugh) Oh, boy.

5 (A very long pause)

6 MCGILL: Boy, I can't stand that DUKE.

7 REAGAN: (UI)

8 MCGILL: I can't stand that DUKE.

9 REAGAN: What was that?

10 MCGILL: The DUKE, UNIVERSITY.

11 REAGAN: Aw.

12 MCGILL: They to me...

13 REAGAN: They, they lost yesterday.

14 MCGILL: Oh, man.

15 REAGAN: (UI)

16 MCGILL: That brother, brother, that brother, MAY, he
17 killed 'em under the board.

18 REAGAN: USC took it to them.

19 MCGILL: Took it to the ass, man, and beat 'em to
20 death under there. And, but, but the thing that I
21 think that DUKE exemplifies for these white folk in
22 this country is that a white team, a predominantly
23 white team, can, can beat anybody. And I, they, I, I
24 don't like it. I, those announcers are awful when,
25 when they have those kinda teams on there. And when I

1 see them get taken care of, boy, that makes my day.
2 (Pause)
3 REAGAN: All them big teams got knocked off this
4 weekend.
5 MCGILL: Oh, yeah, man, that ahh, was that OHIO did
6 it to ILLINOIS?
7 REAGAN: (UI), I don't even watch it.
8 MALE VOICE: (UI)
9 MCGILL: Hmmm, even the MAVERICKS lost, hmmm.
10 REAGAN: Yeah, they did.
11 MCGILL: I, I didn't think they were gonna win, I
12 didn't think they were gonna lose that badly though.
13 And, and maybe they'll come to their senses and
14 realize how important DAMPIER...
15 REAGAN: Oh, they do.
16 MCGILL: ...is to that team.
17 REAGAN: Oh, they do.
18 MCGILL: But, MCGRADY had a ball yesterday.
19 (Laughing) That brother was driving the middle like
20 it was, like he owned it.
21 REAGAN: Who's that?
22 MCGILL: Hmmm, MCGRADY.
23 REAGAN: Be nice to see ole' CHRIS (UI) back in
24 the house.
25 MCGILL: Yeah, man. And he just seems to be a nice

1 kid, really. (Stuttering) Ain't...

2 REAGAN: (UI)

3 MCGILL: ...coming with his head inflated. He, I

4 mean, that was a nice article in the paper, some nice

5 quotes. I mean, you know, he said, hey, I got a long

6 ways to go. You know, and it would be nice if, if,

7 you know, if I'm known as the best player, he said,

8 but I've, I've got a long ways to go before I get to a

9 LARRY JOHNSON.

10 (Pause)

11 REAGAN: Well, brother, I'm gonna finish up lunch on

12 BILL, and I'm gonna have to get the hell on outta

13 here, I told him.

14 MCGILL: Okay.

15 REAGAN: I gotta get outta here. (Laugh)

16 MCGILL: Hey.

17 REAGAN: (Laugh) So, this gonna be a real short one

18 when he show up.

19 MCGILL: Well,...

20 REAGAN: He ain't got no contract.

21 MCGILL: Ain't nothing really to, to really discuss

22 with him really. Well, brother, enjoy your lunch.

23 REAGAN: I'll holler back at you Al after we finish.

24 MCGILL: Okay. Bye, bye.
