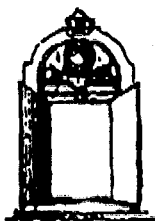



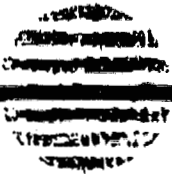

Call 382-2323 for a recorded announcement of ticket availabilities and times. Full price tickets are available in advance and on the day of performance at theater box offices.


