Om: Also, I want..., what is his name, the man you have in Lebanon, the phone number of a good man, someone who can receive Faheem.

Sh: Yes.

Om: We will send him to Palestine, Jordan and Lebanon.

Sh: Fine.

Om: I just need the phone number of someone for him to call, receive him and take him to...

Sh: I can give the phone number of this guy, what is his name...er.

Om: Eid.

Sh: Ok, fine. Do you want it now?

Om: I mean, tomorrow if you're busy or next week.

Sh: Fine.

Om: It is needed for next week before he leaves.

Sh: Fine, I will get it because there is this young man, Maraei...

Om: Yeah.
