


Elf Owl Surveys in the LCR MSCP planning area





Conservation Measures

- Create 1784 ac of elf owl habitat (CW I, II and HM III) in reaches 3 to 5
- Install nest boxes until habitat has matured

- California Department of Fish and Game 1998, 1999, 2000



- Site reconnaissance




Historic Locations

Mature Restoration Projects

- CRIT 8 and 9 'Ahakav Preserve

2004 vegetation maps

CW I, II and HM III habitat selected

- Havasu NWR-9 sites
- Cibola NWR (Walkers Lake area)
- Imperial NWR (Draper and Adobe Lake)

Habitat reconnaissance

 Small mature cottonwood/willow areas on Havasu NWR

Survey Methods

- Arizona Game and Fish Department recommended methods –Michael Ingraldi and Shawn Lowery
- Three surveys at each site 25 March to 31 May
- Call stations 150 m apart
- 2 minute listening, 4 X 30 sec elf owl call/ 90 sec listening, 2 minute listening
- 30 min after sunset to 1:00 AM

Results

- No elf owls detected
- Owl species detected
- Great-horned owl
- Western screech-owl
- Barn owl
- Northern saw-whet owl
- Long-eared owl

Future Plans

- Survey same sites as in 2008
 FY10
- Detectability Study
 - Hardy and Morrison 2000 (temporal, lunar, weather, and biological)
 - Boal and Bibles 2001 (conspecific and great horned owl calls)
