On July 27, 2005, the Steering Committee approved by consensus the following resolution regarding disposal of the SunSparc Computer Work Station (moved by Bill Werner and seconded by Tom Hine):

Resolution 05-007

Based upon an investigation by Mr. Christopher Harris and Mr. Phillip Lehr, it has been determined that there is little to no value to be gained in retaining or utilizing the SunSparc 20 computer workstation during implementation of the LCR MSCP. The SunSparc 20 workstation was purchased during the early years of LCR MSCP development. All of the functions originally performed on the SunSparc 20 workstation are now performed on PC-based platforms. Therefore, it is the motion of the LCR MSCP Steering Committee, that the authorized representative of the Steering Committee, Mr. Christopher Harris, contact an appropriate electronics recycling center in the Los Angeles area and arrange for disposal of the hardware and related peripheral equipment.
