Whereas, the LCR MSCP has been participating with numerous parties including the Yuma Crossing National Heritage to evaluate the restoration and maintenance of habitat at Hunter's Hole;

Whereas, a decision document (PDD 11-001) has been prepared which anticipates that the Hunter's Hole will provide at least 50 acres of cottonwood-willow land cover type within Reach 7;

Whereas, additional acreage may be incorporated into the Hunter's Hole in the future and additional covered species habitat may be developed through the adaptive management at the site;

Whereas the Program Manager is recommending that the Hunter's Hole be included within the LCR MSCP; now, therefore, be it

Resolved that the Steering Committee concurs with the recommendation to include the Hunter's Hole into the Lower Colorado River Multi-Species Conservation Program
