**Clanton**– The Alabama Emergency Management Agency announced today Disaster Loan Outreach Centers will open in Jefferson, Montgomery and Morgan Counties to help those whose homes or businesses that were damaged by the December 24 through 31 severe storms flooding.

Representatives from the Alabama Emergency Management Agency, U.S. Small Business Administration and other agencies will be at the center to answer questions about available disaster assistance.
