

I-Suite Patch 12-1 Release Notes

Date: July 30, 2012 **Version:** I-Suite 12.01.01

Description: The focus of this patch is to address several minor application issues impacting the field. All changes included in this patch are identified in the Summary Release Information section of this document.

Things to know prior to installing I-Suite Patch 12-1, Version 12.01.01

 There are two different patches available depending on your configuration and operating system. See chart below:

- Recommend that this patch be installed on all computers running I-Suite 12.01.00.
- This patch can be applied to a server or client installation of I-Suite.
- System Administrative privileges are required to properly install this patch.
- This patch can be installed mid-incident.
- For both Server and Client computers, close the I-Suite application and all related windows on the local computer before installing this patch.
- It is recommended that a back-up of the I-Suite database be made prior to any application updates.
- The installation of I-Suite Patch 12-1 will replace the following files: ISuite.exe, Reports Folder.
- Opening the I-Suite application on the server computer, attaching a database, and creating a new database will update the database to version 12.01.08.
