The primary focus of this patch is to address two cost calculation issues and minor application defects. The installation of I-Suite Patch 12-2 will replace the following files: ISuite.exe and all report files.

Opening the I-Suite application on the server computer, attaching a database, and creating a new database will update the database to version 12.01.11.

System Administrative privileges are required to properly install this patch and it can be installed mid-incident.
