Observers Meeting for Comet 2013 A1 (Siding Spring)

August 11, 2014

Comet Siding Spring will fly within 132,000 km of Mars on 19 October 2014. Both Earth-based and Mars-based assets are planning observations that will increase understanding of its orbit, nucleus size, density, strength, rotation rate, composition, coma and tail morphology, and evolution over time. Observers will also search for possible effects of cometary dust and gas on the Mars atmosphere, relevant to understanding the delivery of cometary water and organics to inner planets. In order to facilitate the maximal observing of Siding Spring, a 1-day observers' discussion will be held on 11 August 2014. There are a limited number of Web-Ex connections still available.
