

2015 High Water Mark Signs – Created signs and surveyed elevations for reference lines.


2016 Online Story Map – Will provide online story map of historic flood photos and location specific information to be connected with the High Water Mark Signs.

PROBLEM AND NEED:

Damaging flood events continue to occur annually, causing loss of life, high financial damages to public buildings, critical facilities, and residential, commercial, and industrial centers. Nebraska Silver Jackets has created high water mark signs to be placed in public areas. These signs will create a sense of familiarity and recognition in the public by sharing personal and relevant stories that people can connect with and bringing the severity of potential floods into perspective.



LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:

Historical Marker signs are being developed for Plattsmouth, Omaha, Hickman, Lincoln, Grand Island, Louisville, Scottsbluff, Howells, Hooper, Dannebrog, and Schuyler, Nebraska. The signs have information on historic flooding in that area, reference lines for base flood elevations, and recent 2011 flood information where applicable. A link is included on the sign which directs the public to more location specific information and an interactive map.
