### Treaty Review Comments

1. I want the Treaty Review team to consider these issues:

Navigation impacts due to high/low/highly varying flow. Includes impacts to newly deepened Lower Columbia River channel, sediment accumulation in and along shorelines/docks of the river. This, combined with changing regulatory restrictions on dredge material management, will greatly effect the river system's ability to perform.

2. Is there any key information we missed in our Iteration 2 assessment? Any gaps in our analysis?

Just a need from the navigation community for modeling on the variability of projected flow changes in order to consider further impacts, and to better understand the projected flow levels.
