• Amend Section 961, Title 16, California Code of Regulations, as follows:

§ 961. <u>Online Training and</u> Text and Reference Books for Students.

(a) In teaching, <u>approved</u> schools shall use text and reference books approved by the board <u>National Interstate Council of State Boards of Cosmetology (NIC)</u>. They <u>Approved schools</u> may use other teaching material <u>or on-line training programs</u>, in lieu of the text book, under the <u>condition that they have been approved by the NIC</u> to supplement the approved text and reference books.

(b) Each student shall possess the following:

(1) At least one (1) of the textbooks approved by the board <u>NIC or have access to a NIC-approved online program</u>.

(2) The Barbering and Cosmetology Act and the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Barbering and Cosmetology.

(c) There shall be available for the use of students in the school:

(1) A list of the text and reference books approved by the <u>NIC</u> board.

(2) Any two approved texts other than the one text <u>or online program access</u>, possessed by the student. (Shall not apply to barber schools if there are less than three approved texts.)
