Board Powers: Title 34, Chapter 11 of the Code of Alabama grants the Board the power to reprimand, censure, place on probation, or fine (up to \$2,500 per violation) any licensee, intern or certificated firm found guilty of violations of the Chapter or the Rules of the Board. It also authorizes the Board to assess a civil penalty (up to \$2,500 per violation) to any un-licensed person or un-certificated firm found guilty of violations of the Chapter.
