Board Powers: Title 34, Chapter 11 of the Code of Alabama grants the Board the power reprimand, censure, place on probation, or fine (up to \$2,500 per violation) any licensee, interprimate or certificated firm found guilty of violations of the Chapter or the Rules of the Board. It all authorizes the Board to assess a civil penalty (up to \$2,500 per violation) to any un-license.
