It was determined that a quorum was present.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed. The new agenda items were briefed.

13-065. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Foust to adopt the revised agenda. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Minutes of the second meeting of the 2012-2013 Board held December 6-7, 2012 were received for approval.

13-066. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Barter that the minutes of the second meeting of the 2012-2013 Board held on December 6-7, 2012 be approved as corrected. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Actions from previous board meetings were reviewed.

#### FORMAL HEARING

Staff briefed the Board that a Motion for Continuance was granted by the Administrative Law Judge in Case No. 2012-14-B and the scheduled formal hearing was cancelled.

**APPLICATIONS** – Mr. Phillip E. Santora, Advisor

The Board previously authorized Executive Director to approve applications for licensure, intern certification, and examinations if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. All applications for licensure, intern certification and examinations issued since the December 6-7, 2012 Board Meeting were reviewed.

- 13-069. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the Board approves for examination those applicants listed as approved on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

#### LAW ENFORCEMENT - Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board was briefed on the 2012 - 2013 statistics.

The Board reviewed enforcement actions taken against Alabama licensees by other licensing jurisdictions and criminal convictions that were self-reported during the 2013 license renewal cycle.

13-070. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Santora that the cases listed as "OH1", "KS1", "MS1", "MS2", "AR1", "OK1", "OK2", "TN1", "SC2", "VA1", and NC1", be notified that copies of the actions will be placed in their Alabama licensing files. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action.

- 13-073. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Arnold to close Case 12-32-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Willis recused.
- 13-074. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks to close Case 12-39-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Santora recused.

The Board postponed discussion of the remaining pending enforcement cases to begin a Formal Hearing scheduled for 9:00 a.m.

#### FORMAL HEARING

Mr. Harry Chandler plead guilty to a felony relating to conspiracy to commit bribery and his professional engineer license was revoked 10/11/2007 by an agreed upon consent order. Mr. Chandler's civil rights have been restored, and he has filed an application for reissuance of his professional engineer license and requested a hearing on the matter. Upon completion of the hearing the Board went into executive session for deliberation.

13-075. IT WAS MOVED at 9:35 A.M. by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors go into Executive Session for the purpose of deliberation on Mr. Chandler's request. Dr. Turner, and Misters Foust, Arnold, Barter, Wilbanks, Santora, and Willis voted in favor of the motion.

Chair Turner announced the Board would reconvene into open session in approximately 30 minutes. The meeting was closed to the public.

The meeting was opened to the public at 9:42 A.M.

13-076. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Arnold to approve Mr. Chandler's request for reissuance of his previously revoked professional engineer license. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

#### LAW ENFORCEMENT - Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board continued its review of the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee.

- 13-077. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Foust that there was probable cause that Mr. Benjamin A. Young, PE #19737 failed to provide documentation of his 2012 claimed continuing professional competency credits in response to the Board's audit. The accepted terms of the consent order are that Mr. Young's professional engineer license is on probation for one year, he will pay \$500 fine to the Board, complete fifteen professional continuing competency hours to meet the 2012 requirement and the fifteen professional continuing competency hours need to meet the 2013 requirement, his professional engineer license shall be subject to audit of claimed continuing professional competency credits twice within seven years, and the matter will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Santora recused. (Case 12-36-B)
- 13-078. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Willis to close Case 13-06-C with no action. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Santora recused.
- 13-079. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Santora to close Case 13-07-C with no action. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Foust recused.

**APPLICATIONS** – Mr. Phillip E. Santora, Advisor

13-080. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Santora that the Board go into executive session at 10:00 a.m. to consider applications without personal appearance, evaluation of transcripts and for deliberations regarding ALJ Recommended Final Order (Case # 2012-17-B) Dr. Turner and Misters Santora, Arnold, Wilbanks, Foust, Willis and Barter voted in favor of the motion.

Chair Turner announced the Board would reconvene into open session in approximately one hour. The meeting was closed to the public. The meeting returned to open session at 11:40 A.M.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Engineer Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

Jordan Tyner, Joseph Miller Black IV, Ryan Bailey Crane, Adam Craig Mills, Joshua Allen Knight, Joshua Thomas Greenwell, Bobak Shahnami, Christopher Ryan Fields, Jacob Matthew Bonds, and Matthew Joseph Boos. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

13-087. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Willis that the Board deny for examination applicants Addie Hunter, Katherine Cross and William Alexander. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed a request for board evaluation of transcript from an applicant who wished to be considered for engineering licensure on the basis of obtaining a related to engineering science degree.

13-088. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Santora that Jessica Henson's undergraduate degree be approved as an unaccredited engineering degree as it applies to engineering licensure. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed a request for board evaluation of transcript from an applicant who wished to be considered for land surveying licensure on the basis of obtaining a related to surveying or a related science degree.

13-089. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Santora that applicant Xutong Niu be approved as a related science graduate and as a graduate of an approved land surveying degree category. The related science category requires successfully passing the Fundamentals of Surveying examination, and 96 months of qualifying experience, recognizing that the doctorate will meet 24 months of the experience requirement. The land surveying category requires successfully passing the Fundamentals of Surveying examination, taking or auditing Boundary Law and the Fundamentals of Surveying courses, and 36 months of acceptable experience after the completion of the courses. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

#### LAW ENFORCEMENT – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board continued review of the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee.

13-090. IT WAS MOVED by Santora and seconded by Mr. Willis that the Board accept the recommendations of the Administrative Law Judge and issue a Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0-1. Mr. Barter abstained and Wilbanks was recused. (Case 12-17-B)

The Board recessed for lunch and the Board meeting reconvened at 1:10 P.M. Mr. Willis left the meeting and was no longer available.

#### **CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION** – Mr. Marc S. Barter, Advisor

The Board previously authorized Executive Director to issue certificates of authorization to those firms filing if application is in order and all requirements have been met. A list of 24 Certificates of Authorization issued to engineering firms (CA-4538-E through CA-4561-E) and 3 Certificates of

Authorization issued to land surveying firms (CA-1008-S through CA-1010-S) since the December 6-7, 2012 Board Meeting were reviewed.

13-091. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Board ratify the approval of Engineering Certificates of Authorization CA-4538-E through CA-4561-E and Surveying Certificates of Authorization CA-1008-S through CA1010-S issued since the December 6-7, 2012 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4.** MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Board was asked by Gregori Construction & Engineering Inc to consider waiving the certificate of authorization requirements. The firm is a construction and engineering company that has the title "Engineering" in its name, and is seeking to only offer construction services in Alabama. Their request to operate under the name Gregori Construction & Engineering Inc, or a doing business as (dba) name had been disapproved by the Secretary of State.

13-092. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Barter to deny Gregori Construction & Engineering Inc.'s request for an exemption to the certificate of authorization requirements. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

**LEGISLATIVE** – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board discussed possible changes to the licensure law to be drafted into legislation for the 2013 General Session. Executive Director will be monitoring legislation beginning next week and will send everyone a copy of the 2013 Bill matrix via email.

FINANCE - Dr. Daniel S. Turner, Advisor

Financial reports for November and December 2012 were reviewed.

#### **CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION** – Mr. Marc S. Barter, Advisor

The law firm, Bradley Arant Boult Cummings on behalf of its client, Cytec Engineered Materials requested the firm be exempted from the Board's certificate of authorization requirements. The Secretary of State's Office would not allow the firm to operate as Cytec Engineered Materials without Board approval, and would not allow the firm to operate under a doing business as (dba) name since the firm's name was not currently reserved by another firm. The representatives of the law firm explained that the firm is a manufacturing company looking to open a plant in Alabama and does not offer engineering services to the public, but does have the term "Engineered" in its name.

13-093. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Barter that based on the description of services provided by representatives of "Cytec Engineered Materials" to the Board at this open meeting, it is the Board's opinion that the firm can operate in Alabama without a certificate of authorization for engineering. MOTION CARRIED 5-1 with Mr. Santora voting NO.

LAND SURVEYING - Mr. C. Michael Arnold, Advisor

The Board was briefed by Mr. Arnold and Dr. Turner on the current efforts to re-write the state specific land surveying exam. Information was shared regarding completion of the cut scoring session and the recommendations. The Board determined it needed to establish which accepted procedure will be used to determine the pass point for the state specific land surveying exam.

13-094. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Foust to use the Angoff method to set the passing score with the revised examination being offered beginning with the July state specific land surveying exam. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

#### ENGINEERING- EDUCATION & EXAMINATIONS- Mr. Charles P. Willis, Advisor

The Board approved the results of the October FE and PE examinations.

- 13-095. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks to accept the NCEES' recommended cutoff score and that the results of the Fundamentals of Engineering examination given October 27, 2012 be accepted, and further that the ABET graduates who have had transcripts furnished to the Board office be approved for Engineer Intern certification and included in the minutes on **Attachment #2.** MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 13-096. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Arnold to accept the NCEES' recommended cutoff score and that the results of the PE examination given October 26, 2012 be accepted, and further that the list of those issued licensure a result of passing the examination be included in the minutes on **Attachment # 1**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

#### EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

Travel to the various NCEE meetings was approved.

13-097. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Santora to approve all Board Members, Executive Director, Assistant Executive Director, Executive Secretary, and Board Attorney be appointed as delegates to the Annual NCEES Southern Zone Interim Meeting to be held in Biloxi, MS on April 4-6, 2013 and further that Mr. Wilbanks and Mr. Arnold be designated as the funded delegates. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Board was briefed on the need for development of procedures and coordination with National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES) in order to transition to Computer Based Testing (CBT) for the various exams. The Board approved travel that would allow Staff to meet directly with representatives of NCEES.

13-098. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the Executive Director, Assistant Executive Director and the Executive Secretary be approved to travel to NCEES headquarters in Clemson, SC at a date to be determined. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

#### **CORRESPONDENCE**

The Board reviewed various newsletters that required no response.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### Request for Reinstatement Waiver

The Board reviewed a request from Mr. Edward Munns for a waiver of the \$60.00 reinstatement fee for renewal of his license in retired status. Mr. Munns believed he had renewed his license in October because during the online renewal process, he was able to print a simulated pocket card identifying that he had renewed. The Board's on-line renewal system incorrectly allowed the printing of a license pocket card that indicated the license was current until December 31, 2013.

13-099. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Mr. Foust to waive the reinstatement fee and approve Mr. Munns' renewal at \$10.00. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

#### **FARB Conference Recap**

The Board was briefed by staff concerning attendance at the Federation Association of Regulatory Boards (FARB) conference. FARB is a not-for-profit corporation formed to promote public protection and provide a forum for information exchange for associations of regulatory boards and their affiliate stakeholders with interests in professional regulation. The conference included sessions regarding how to improve board relationships with legislative bodies in various districts, the role of board counsel, what "immunity" means for boards, the rights of licensees who have been accused of a licensure violation, First Amendment issues and whether practitioners can prohibit their clients from speech about their services.

#### **Revision of Application Question**

The Board revised the current application question regarding prior criminal charges and convictions. It also outlined automatic deferral procedures for applicants that fail to reveal a criminal conviction or Board disciplinary action on their applications.

#### Certificate of Authorization Renewal

The Board reviewed a 2013 certificate of authorization renewal application submitted by Stuart Consulting Group Inc. that indicated its physical address is 300 State Street, Mobile, Alabama and Mr. Frank Stuart is the PE principal for that office. The application contained a mailing address of 3813 Division Street #200, Metairie, Louisiana and indicated Mr. Stuart's address is Metairie, LA. The distance between the two offices is approximately 148 miles. Mr. Stuart provided a letter that indicated he alternates his time between the Mobile and Metairie offices.

13-100. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Mr. Santora to deny the certificate of authorization renewal application for Stuart Consulting Group, Inc. MOTION CARRIED 6-0

#### **Qualification Based Selection**

The Board discussed the current Administrative Code section that requires a qualification based selection process for engineering and land surveying services. In 2011 the Board adopted a position statement for guidance for complying with the QBS requirement, and recent concerns have been brought to the Board regarding language in the position statement. Dr. Turner agreed to revise the position statement.

#### Request for Waiver of Reinstatement Fee

World Fiber Technologies submitted a request for waiver of the certificate of authorization reinstatement fee which goes into effect January 31, 2013. Mr. Mike Holt, their designated principal engineer, is no longer with the company, and the individual that replaced Mr. Holt has not yet received an Alabama licensee and cannot be designated as the principal. Mr. Urban informed Board staff that he is in the process of expediting his application, which has not yet been received in the Board office. The company has identified that it has no other Alabama licensee on staff so it can not renew its Certificate of Authorization prior to the deadline. A company is allowed 30 days in which to notify the Board who the new principal is for a Certificate of Authorization.

13-101. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Mr. Santora to deny World Fiber Technologies request for waiver of the reinstatement fee required for renewal a certificate of authorization after January 31st. MOTION CARRIED 5-1with Mr. Wilbanks voting NO.
