MINUTES OF FOURTH MEETING 2015-2016 BOARD OF LICENSURE

FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS

Chair Barter called the fifth meeting of the 2015-2016 Board to order at 12:00 P.M., Wednesday, June 1, 2016 at the Board Office, Montgomery, Alabama. The following were in attendance:

It was determined that a quorum was present. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed. Additional agenda items were identified and were added to the agenda under New Business.

16-084. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson to adopt the proposed agenda as amended. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Minutes of the fourth meeting of the 2015-2016 Board were received for approval.

16-085. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Grace that the minutes of the fourth meeting of the 2015-2016 Board held March 30-31, 2016 be approved as written. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Action items from previous board meetings were reviewed. The new method to track action items was explained. The Board agreed with the new system so the staff will develop the necessary files.

FORMAL HEARING

The formal hearing that was originally scheduled for Case 2014-33-B had been cancelled since the respondent has signed a consent order. The Board was briefed on the provisions of the Consent Order. It was noted that remittance for the fine had been included but the cost of the investigation was missing.

16-086. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Johnson to accept the proposed Consent Order and conditionally issue the Final Order for Case 2014-33-B. It was determined that there was probable cause that Mr. Marshall Wayne Corlew, PE #12775 had placed his signature and seal to plans that contained errors and were generally incomplete. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are Mr. Corlew's professional engineer's license will be suspended for two years with that suspension stayed; he will pay to the Board a \$2,500 fine and \$275.00 for the cost of the investigation; he agrees to provide a quarterly list to the Board of the engineering projects he has performed, three projects of which will be selected from the list for review; and the Consent Order and Final Order will be a public record. The Board will issue a Final Order pending the receipt of a \$275.00 check to cover the cost of the investigation. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Christy recused.

LAW ENFORCEMENT - Ms. M. Elisabeth Hyde, Advisor

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board was briefed on the 2015-2016 statistics.

The Board reviewed the recommended order provided by Ms. Billingsley, Administrative Law Judge, who had heard the hearing on March 30, 2016 against Mr. Roddy Fitzgerald. (Cases 2015-19-C, 2015-33-C, 2015-34-C, 2015-38-C and 2015-44-C.)

16-087. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Grace to go into executive session in order to deliberate. Ms. Hyde, Misters Barter, Christy, Grace, Johnson, and Whorton voted in the affirmative.

Mr. Albritton, Board Attorney, concurred that the reason to go into executive session was valid. Prior to going into executive session, Mr. Barter announced that the executive session would last approximately 15 minutes. The Board went into executive session at 12:45 P.M. and came back into open session at 12:55 P.M.

16-088. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde to accept the recommendations of the Administrative Law Judge with modifications. Due to the severity of the issues, the civil penalty was increased to \$25,000 payable to the General Fund plus \$5,243.75 for the cost of the hearing payable to the Board. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Board reviewed the transcript and the recommended order for Mr. James Glenn Karolyi, Case 2015-48-B (Mr. Grace directing), for a hearing that had been held without the Board present.

16-089. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson to accept the recommended order from the Administrative Law Judge with the modification that Mr. Karolyi's PE license will remain in suspended status until he completes the audit requirements and pays the fine and the cost of the hearing. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Grace recused.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action. Cases that are being recommended for closure or where they are recommendations from the investigative committee are discussed in a sanitized format so that in the event the Board suggests another course of action that the due process of the investigation has not been compromised. Respondent's information is not divulged until after a proposed consent order is accepted and a final order is approved.

- 16-090. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Grace to accept the proposed Consent Order and issue the Final Order for Case 2016-02-C. It was determined that there was probable cause that Brown Machine & Fabrication, an uncertificated firm had offered engineering and design services without employing a licensed professional engineer and obtaining a certificate of authorization for engineering. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are Brown Machine & Fabrication must cease and desist advertising engineering on its web site, the firm must pay the Board \$200 for the cost of the investigation and must pay a civil penalty of \$250 to the General Fund. The Consent Order and Final Order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Barter recused.
- 16-091. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde to accept the proposed Consent Order and issue the Final Order for Case 2016-03-C. It was determined that there was probable cause that Mr. James A. Mitchell, a registered architect had performed engineering without first being licensed as a professional engineer. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Mr. Mitchell will cease and desist the practice, or the offer to practice engineering in Alabama, he will pay the Board \$925 for the cost of the investigation and must pay a civil penalty of \$2,000 to the General Fund. The Consent Order and Final Order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Grace recused.
- 16-092. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Grace to accept the proposed Consent Order and issue the Final Order for Case 2016-04-B. It was determined that there was probable cause that Mr. John Farrior Crenshaw, PLS #29978 had signed and sealed a survey that contained violations of the standards of practice for land surveying in Alabama. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Mr. Crenshaw's PLS license will be suspended for 2 years with that suspension being stayed, he will pay the Board \$2500 fine, and he must provide to the Board upon request a list of surveying jobs performed within one-month period during the stayed suspension with the surveys being randomly selected for compliance review. The Consent Order and Final Order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Christy recused.

- 16-093. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Grace to close Case 2016-06-B with no formal action, MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Johnson recused.
- 16-094. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Grace to close Case 2016-11-B with no formal action. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Johnson recused.
- 16-096. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Grace to close Case 2016-15-C with no formal action. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 16-097. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Grace to accept the proposed Consent Order and issue the Final Order for Case 2016-14-B. It was determined that there was probable cause that Mr. Robin Daniel Bell, PE #32141, had plead guilty to a felony. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are Mr. Bell's PE license is revoked and he may not apply for reissuance of that license for a period of 3 years from the date of the Final Order. The Consent Order and Final Order will be a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Whorton recused.

APPLICATIONS - Mr. Nathan Johnson, Advisor

The Board previously authorized the Executive Director to approve applications for licensure, intern certification, and examinations if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. All applications for licensure, intern certification and examinations issued since the March 30-31, 2016 Board meeting were reviewed.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Engineer Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

16-098. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Grace that the Board ratify the approval of licenses issued since the March 30-31, 2016 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**; ratify the approval of Intern Certifications issued since the March 30-31, 2016 Board Meeting and that the list of those be included in the minutes on **Attachment #2**; and ratify the approval for

examination those applicants approved since the March 30-31, 2016 meeting and listed as approved on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

- 16-099. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Whorton that the Board defers for licensure Shae Stephen Hoschek and Ravinder Singh Bassi. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 16-100. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Grace and seconded by Mr. Whorton that the Board denies for licensure Mark Steven Frey and Nasser Karimzadeh. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 16-101. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Grace that the Board approve for examination those applicants listed as "approved" on Attachment #3. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 16-102. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Grace that the Board defer for examination those applicants listed as "deferred" on Attachment #3. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 16-103. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Christy that the Board deny for examination those applicants listed as "denied" on Attachment #3. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Board reviewed a request from Mr. Erik Vogt who was asking the Board to determine which category his education could be accepted for professional land surveying licensure. The Board determined that Mr. Vogt's BS in Building Science would be accepted as a related science category for land surveying licensure.

CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION – Mr. Marc S. Barter, Advisor

The Board previously authorized the Executive Director to issue certificates of authorization to applying firms if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. A list of the certificate of authorizations issued since the March 2016 Board Meeting were reviewed.

16-104. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson that the Board ratify the approval of the Engineering and Land Surveying Certificates of Authorization issued since the February 2016 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes of Attachment #4. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Board discussed the Certificate of Authorization applications that had exceptions. The Board determined it would not discuss the application for Bowers Engineering Services, LLC until the application is complete. The staff was also asked to notify Centurion Industries about the problems with their CA.

16-105. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde to deny the application for Fontaine Engineering LLC. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

COMMUNICATIONS - Mr. Charles Willis, Advisor

The efforts to educate the licensees on the benefits of continuing education and how to be compliant with the Board's PDH requirements were discussed. The Board was shown the brochure that had been developed that provides examples of proper classes and documentation plus examples of non-compliant PDH's. Mr. Willis is writing an article for inclusion in the June newsletter on the benefits of continuing education.

Griffin Pritchard briefed the Board on the various publication efforts that are in development or are planned. Draft brochures were reviewed. Details of the June 16th webinar on sealing requirements were briefed. The brochures will be finalized and will be available on the web site. Links to the brochures will be included in the newsletter.

LEGISLATURE - Ms. M. Elisabeth Hyde, Advisor

Legislation that had been filed in the 2016 General Session was briefed. Emphasis was placed on getting the proposed changes to the Licensure Law finalized so that legislation for 2017 can be pre-filed.

FINANCE - Mr. Richard Grace, Advisor

Financial reports for December through April were reviewed.

The Board was briefed by Robert Herbert on the proposals that he had received for the upgrade of the audio and visual board room systems. The concepts provided by Moffitt Technology, Venture Technologies, and Clear Solutions were reviewed. The Board instructed the staff to continue with the process to purchase a system.

LAND SURVEYING – Mr. A. Frazier Christy, Advisor

The Board approved the results of the April 2016 PS and state specific surveying examinations.

16-106. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Grace to accept NCEES' recommended cutoff score for the PS and the ALSS Examinations, to approve the results of the PS and ALSS Exams given April 2016, to license those individuals who passed the PLS and ALLS Exams having previously passed the FLS Exam and further that the list of those issued licensure as a result of passing these examinations be included in the minutes on Attachment #1. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

ENGINEERING

The Board approved the results of the April 2016 PE examinations.

16-107. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Whorton to accept NCEES' recommended cutoff score for the PE Examination, to approve the results of the PE Exam given April 2016, to license those individuals who passed the PE having previously passed the FE Exam and further that the list of those issued licensure as a result of passing these examinations be included in the minutes on Attachment #1. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board meeting adjourned at 5:20 P.M. The Board reconvened June 2, 2016 at 8:00 A.M. with all board members present.

CHAIR'S REPORT

A question had been asked if a block name in a signature block would be acceptable as an electronic signature. The Board discussed the guidance and requirements for digital signatures and seals that are contained in the Administrative Code. It was determined that a block signature met our requirements if the other requirements are met. It was noted that nothing is foolproof and that during the webinar on seals that a caution of protecting your seals/signatures and the need to keep good records should be included.

The Board reviewed the 2013, 2014, and 2015 Annual Reports.

16-108. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Christy to accept the annual reports. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The Board reviewed the requests for qualifications that had been received from engineering and land surveying firms to provide a monitoring service as board technical advisors. The Board identified those firms that would be best qualified to perform the services required. Specific provisions for the contracts were identified including confidentiality statements, travel reimbursement, the requirement for E & O insurance, the maximum per hour rate, and a maximum cap on a two-year contract. Contract language meeting the agreed upon requirements will be developed and will be sent to the selected firms.

16-109. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Christy that there should be a maximum of seven contracts for technical advisors at an hourly fee of \$50.00 for a maximum of \$50,000 in a two-year contract. Additionally, the contracted advisors should only be used on complex cases under investigation and the monitoring requirements. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board was briefed on the procedures that the Legislative Reference Service will be using to provide the rule making oversight responsibility that they have been given with the passage of Senate Bill 80.

The Board elected then to discuss an agenda item that had been identified in Old Business since it dealt with the oversight issue. The Board reviewed all the issues with the Quality Based Selection (QBS) requirements contained in the Board's rules.

16-110. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Christy that, with a sense of urgency, a request be sent to LRS asking for a review of the rules involving QBS. The request should include reference to the U.S. Supreme Court decision, the background of the rule(s) adoption, the Board's adopted position statement, and any other officially adopted society position statements. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSILY.

Those that were planning on attending the NCEES Annual Meeting were identified.

16-111. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Grace and seconded by Mr. Johnson that Mr. Christy and Ms. Hyde should be designated as the NCEES funded delegates. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

OLD BUSINESS

The Board reviewed the changes proposed to the draft Position Statement on Subdivision Certification Statements that had been submitted by the Association of County Engineers.

16-112. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Willis to adopt the Position State on Subdivision Certification Statements with the proposed changes. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

OPEN FORUM

No comments made during the open forum.

CLOSING REMARKS

The agenda item about a renewal payment was deleted since the issue had been resolved the day of the board meeting after the agenda had been adopted.
