PSE Industry Member Qualifications

Individuals who hold, or are associated with, a current Bureau PPSE registration or are a member of an association relating to the PPSE industry are eligible to serve for this industry member position.

Public Member Qualifications

Individuals who DO NOT hold a current Bureau license, permit, certificate, or registration are eligible to serve in a public member position. Desirable qualifications for public members include individuals with a background in consumer protection/advocacy or law enforcement, as well as individuals involved with businesses and agencies that deal with Bureau licensees.

Committee Information

The Committee is an informal committee comprised of voluntary members who provide insight and perspective to the Bureau on policy issues relating to the Locksmith, Repossessor, Private Investigator, Proprietary Security Services, Private Security Services including Bureau-certified firearm and baton training facilities and instructors, and Alarm Company industries in California.

Members serve at the pleasure of the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs (DCA). An appointment to the Committee does not constitute employment with the State of California and no salary or benefits are associated with a Committee position. Committee members serve a two-year appointment term with appointments to a second term at the discretion of the DCA Director.

The Committee meets two to four times a year and all meetings are held in the Sacramento area. Members are responsible for all costs incurred to attend and participate in Committee meetings since as an informal committee the Bureau does not have the authority to provide reimbursement.
