4.14.1 OUTPATIENT HOUSING UNIT POLICY	Attachments: Yes 🗌 No 🖂

I. POLICY

Outpatient Housing Units (OHUs) shall be maintained to house patients who require outpatient health services and assistance with the activities of daily living.

II. PURPOSE

To provide patients with housing consistent with their medical/mental/dental health level of care necessary to protect life, or prevent significant illness or disability.

III.DEFINITIONS

Outpatient Housing Unit: A designated housing area within institutions designed to provide supportive services for patients who may require limited assistance with activities of daily living or short term observations.

IV. RESPONSIBILITY

The Chief Executive Officer or designee of each institution is responsible for the implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of this policy.
