## I. PROCEDURE OVERVIEW

The pharmacy shall provide medication information to health care staff and patients.

## II. PURPOSE

To ensure access to medication information for patients and health care staff and improve quality of care through the informed use of medications.

## **III.PROCEDURE**

- A. The pharmacy shall have access to electronic medication information resources. These resources can be accessed on the California Correctional Health Care Services intranet site at <a href="http://lifeline/HealthCareOperations/MedicalServices/Pharmacy/Pages/Home.aspx">http://lifeline/HealthCareOperations/MedicalServices/Pharmacy/Pages/Home.aspx</a> located under External Links.
- B. Under the direction of the Pharmacist-in-Charge or designee, pharmacists provide drug information and when necessary, in-service training related to the safety, proper use, and handling of medications by health care staff.
- C. Pharmacists provide consultation, counseling, or medication information to medical, dental, and mental health staff, and patients when requested and as required by state and federal laws.
- D. The pharmacist shall document pharmacy interventions in the patient's health record.
