






Existing Oregon Freight Plan

Inventory

- Bottlenecks
- Intermodal Connectors
- Develop tiered list of needs

Define system

- Designate critical rural and urban freight corridors
- 155 miles of rural highways
- 77 miles of urban highways
- 20% multimodal

 List priority projects, funds to invest and match


