

## Perform Quality of Life (QoL) Program Management Scope Statement

**Purpose:** The scoping statement is intended only to provide a brief overview of triggering events, outcomes of the business area process, identification of impacted processes, and scope. The details behind the scope statement will be communicated via the presentation of the OV-6c process model.

Business Area Name: Perform Quality of Life Program Management

**Scope:** This activity is associated with managing Quality of Life (QoL) programs on military installations, on property controlled by a Military Department (MILDEP), or furnished by a Department of Defense (DoD) contractor. This activity includes establishing, maintaining, and assessing QoL programs.

**Trigger Events:** Establish Quality of Life (QoL) Program starts when a proposal to establish a QoL program is submitted or resubmitted.

**Trigger Events:** Quality of Life (QoL) Program Maintenance starts when a request to modify or discontinue a Quality of Life program is submitted.

**Trigger Events:** Perform Quality of Life (QoL) Program Assessment starts when a periodic (e.g., annual, every other year, or every three years) assessment of a QoL Program begins.

**Business Area Outcome Information:** Establish Quality of Life (QoL) Program ends when the appropriate parties are notified when a QoL program proposal has a discrepancy, a proposal has been denied, the appropriate parties are notified of a QoL program plan disapproval, or there is a link to workforce communication.

**Business Area Outcome Information:** The Quality of Life (QoL) Program Maintenance ends when the appropriate parties are notified of a QoL program proposal discrepancy, a QoL program has been discontinued, or when there is a link to workforce communication.

**Business Area Outcome Information:** The Quality of Life (QoL) Program Assessment ends when a QoL program report is sent to the appropriate parties.

Business Area(s) Interfacing with this *Perform Quality of Life (QoL) Program Management* activity includes (but not limited to):

<u>Materiel Supply and Services Management</u> - This activity is used to show DoD assistance with inventory, storing, and distribution of DoD material assets and services.

<u>Financial Management</u> - This activity is used to show DoD assistance with all financial aspects (e.g., budgeting, accounting, cost, disbursement of monies) related to a QoL program.

<u>Real Property and Installations Lifecycle Management</u> – This activity is used to show assistance with DoD owned and leased property, installations, buildings, and infrastructure (e.g., water, sewer, power lines).

<u>Manage Workforce Communication</u> - This activity is used to show the dissemination of information about a Quality of Life program to the public.

<u>Perform Workforce Analysis</u> – This activity is used to show the analysis that is conducted regarding available resources needed to establish or modify a QoL program.

<u>Manage Interagency Support</u> - This activity is used to show coordination with DoD and Non-DoD entities to aid in the establishment or modification a QoL program.
