- 3 DELEGATE JONES: Madam Chair, if you want
- 4 to sign the report. I want to thank you last week
- 5 for the amendments that were made to the bill that
- 6 were done on your committee. And then we had a
- 7 couple of technical commitments that were necessary.
- 8 That's the reason why we rejected some. I think you
- 9 had, like, four changes that you need to make.
- 10 MADAM CHAIR: We have over the weekend
- 11 discovered three technical changes. The first is we
- 12 are going to move Mt. Vernon precinct in Roanoke
- 13 County to District 21, and we are going to give
- 14 District 19 all of the two split precincts in
- 15 Montgomery County. So we are eliminating some
- 16 precincts.
- We are going to move Roanoke precinct from
- 18 the twelfth into the eighth district, and move
- 19 Springfield precinct from the eighth into the
- 20 twelfth.
- 21 And then one little, I mean really
- 22 technical, which is to take a census block which is
- 23 under an interstate and reunite it with the county
- 24 where it should be one.
- DELEGATE JONES: Then I had just a couple

- 1 of changes. We are going to unsplit the Birkdale
- 2 precinct which is now in 20, split in 27, all into
- 3 the 66th District. I'm going to then unsplit
- 4 Quantico Precinct which has a part of 52 into the
- 5 House District 2.
- 6 And then we are going to revert the
- 7 original configuration of House District 19 and 22.
- 8 We are going to undo what was done in the senate
- 9 substitute before your committee on Thursday of last
- 10 week.
- 11 And then while we had made the change for
- 12 east Alvey (phonetic) in the committee, we undid the
- 13 split we had in the 59th, I believe, and we took the
- 14 population from the 58th, which is 460 people from
- 15 the Free Bridge precinct to be able to equalize the
- 16 population to plus or minus 50 percent. That's the
- 17 sum and substance of our technical changes that we
- 18 have. And that will constitute, I think, all of the
- 19 acts before the conference committee.
- 20 MADAM CHAIR: I'm glad we were able to find
- 21 these little technical changes in time. Okay.
- 22 DELEGATE JONES: Any comments from the
- 23 committee?
- I think we have the three copies for the
- 25 senate. The three cover pages, and we will have our
