COMMENTS:

At the bid opening, Citywide Contracting, L.L.C. was read as the apparent low bidder with a bid of \$241,160.00. The second low bidder was Southwest Concrete Paving Co. with a bid of \$245,720.00.

The Department issued Addendum No. 2 on July 20. Addendum No. 2 added Item 2030506 – Structure Back-fill with a quantity of 50 cubic yards.

In its bid documents, Citywide failed to acknowledge receipt of Addendum No. 2. In addition, the bid documents contained the original page 1 of the bid schedule and not the revised page 1 of the bid schedule. As a result, Citywide's bid did not include the structure backfill item. This would make Citywide's bid non-responsive.

Subsequently, the Department became aware that Addendum No. 2 had not yet been delivered to Citywide as of the July 22 bid opening. While the Department sent out Addendum No. 2 on July 20, it was not delivered to Citywide until July 27. In doing additional research, the Department realized that the zip code had been inadvertently entered as 85304 instead of 85034. Because of the wrong zip code, the delivery service had taken the package to Glendale instead of Phoenix.

The extended amount submitted by the other bidders for the structure backfill item ranged between \$1,500 and \$7,700. The difference between Citywide's bid without the item and Southwest Concrete's bid with the item is \$4,560.

There is no way of determining who the low bidder would have been if Citywide had included the structure backfill item in its bid. Since the Department caused this situation and not Citywide, staff recommends that the Transportation Board reject all bids and direct staff to readvertise the project.

COMMENTS:

At the bid opening, ELS Construction, Inc. was read as the apparent low bidder with a bid of \$4,677,580.41. The second low bidder was Recon Inc. with a bid of \$5,399,900.00.

Subsequent to the bid opening, ELS Construction requested to withdraw its bid due to a clerical error and submitted documentation supporting the request.

After reviewing the detail summary of ELS Construction's computer spreadsheet reports and final bid preparation documents, it became clear that a clerical error was made in their bid. A unit price of \$38,365.00 was shown on the final bid preparation documents for Item 9240127 - Miscellaneous Work (Landform Graphics). However, a unit price of \$8,365 was written in the bid schedule that was submitted to the Department. An amount of \$38,365.00 is reasonable for the specified work whereas the amount written in the bid schedule is not. Since the bid schedule contained a quantity of 17 for this item, this resulted in a clerical error of \$510,000.

Staff recommends that the apparent low bidder, ELS Construction, Inc., be allowed to withdraw its bid and that the contract be awarded to the second low bidder, Recon Inc. ELS construction is legally justified in withdrawing its bid due to a clerical error. The error stems from writing a unit price in the bid schedule different than what was on the bid worksheet. The error is of such a grave consequence that to enforce a contract would be unconscionable, since the amount of the error is nearly 11 percent of ELS Construction's bid. In addition, the mistake relates to a material feature of the contract, i.e., the proposed contract price. The error did not come about because of a violation of positive legal duty or from culpable negligence. Finally, the State is placed back to the status quo to the extent that the State suffers no serious prejudice except the loss of the benefit of the bar-gain. *See, Marana Unified School District v. Aetna Cas. and Sur. 144 Ariz. 159, 696 P.2d 711 (App. 1985).*

Therefore, staff recommends allowing ELS Construction, Inc. to withdraw its bid without forfeiting its bid bond and recommends that the contract be awarded to Recon Inc.
