


RECOMMENDATION: ALLOW BANICKI TO WITHDRAW CONTINGENT AWARD TO ASHTON

COMMENTS:

Banicki, in a letter dated December 20, 2014, and received by ADOT on December 23, 2014, asked to withdraw its bid due to an error concerning items 2020008A and 2020008B, Removal of Structural Concrete. Banicki based its bid for that work on a quote by a subcontractor that divided the work into two components. Banicki showed that they had entered both components into their bidding software, but the cost for the second component of work did not carry forward into its bid amount for those two items as intended. The result is that the Banicki bid inadvertently underestimated the total cost of items 2020008A and 2020008B by about \$334,700, which is over 15% of the amount of the bid.

The Department reviewed bid documentation provided by Banicki and is satisfied the bid does not represent Banicki's intent for items 2020008A and 2020008B and is satisfied that it resulted from an error in the use of its estimating software rather than an error in judgment. The error is a substantial amount relative to the size of the entire contract, it concerns a material item within the contract, and it would be inequitable to require Banicki to perform the work for the amount stated in its bid. If Banicki had bid the intended amount, its bid would have been about \$61,400 less than the second bid. If Banicki is allowed to withdraw, ADOT would suffer no serious prejudice except the loss of a bargain resulting from an inadvertent error.

The Department recommends that the Board allow Banicki to withdraw its bid without forfeiting its bid bond and that the Board award to Ashton contingent on meeting the DBE requirements.



RECOMMENDATION: CONTINGENT AWARD

COMMENTS:

The low bidder, TK Construction US, LLC, is not presently licensed by the Arizona Registrar of Contractors (ROC). Section 102.16 of the Standard Specifications states in part, for projects using federal funds, that the bidder "... must procure the licenses before award can be made, and no later than 60 days after the date bids are opened." Because bids were opened on December 5, 2014, TK Construction US LLC has until February 3, 2015, to obtain the appropriate ROC licensing for this project and has been notified in writing of this requirement.

The Department recommends award to TK Construction US, LLC, contingent on TK Construction US, LLC, showing the Department on or before close of business on February 3, 2015, that it has obtained the appropriate ROC licensing, with award to be effective the date of the notification to the department that the contractor obtained the appropriate license, and further recommends that the bid of TK Construction US, LLC, be rejected if it does not show the Department by close of business on February 3, 2015, that it has obtained the ROC licensing. In the event the bid of TK Construction US, LLC, is rejected, the Department will bring this project to a future board meeting.
