7-17-13¹ **CURTIN HEARING CASE 13GG082**

Today's hearing was continued when exercise rider Patricia Curtin requested a continuance to obtain counsel. Curtin is charged with violations of CHRB rule #1489 (H), 1900, 1890 (A) and 1843 (c). All violations pertain to drug possession and possession of contraband. The hearing will be held at Santa Rosa on 8/1/13.

7-17-13² **CLAIM VOID – 3RD RACE**

The claim submitted in the 3rd race for "REAGAN REPUBLICAN" was deemed void after being placed on the Veterinarian's List, by Official Veterinarian Forrest Franklin, for lameness.

7-17-13³ **CLAIM VOID – 4th RACE**

The claim submitted in the 4th race for "AUTISM AWAKENESS" was deemed void after being placed on the Veterinarian's List, by Official Veterinarian Forrest Franklin, for lameness.

7-17-13⁴ FIRE IN VIDEO DEPARTMENT

Shortly after the sixth race Pegasus Video Supervisor Frank Matthews called to say a fire had started in the air conditioning unit. Emergency Services (Fire Department) were on the scene in good order and things were back to normal before the seventh race.

7-18-13¹ MEDELES-RUIZ HEARING CASE 13GG065 (Ref. 7/14/13¹ and 7/13/13¹)

A hearing was convened concerning the failure to appear suspension and to address alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) for Monica Medeles-Ruiz.

Ms. Medeles-Ruiz was suspended for failure to appear on 7/14/13 in Ruling #1 here at Cal-Expo. She wished to address the charges today.

Present at the hearing were Stewards Grant Baker, Paul Nicolo and Will Meyers. Also, present were defendant Monica Medeles-Ruiz and the case presenter Senior Special Investigator Louis Quezada. The proceeding was recorded by Shari Carter.

Ms. Medeles-Ruiz admitted to the use of amphetamine/methamphetamine and losing her cool. She tested positive for the aforementioned drugs on 5/31/13 at Pleasanton. Quest Diagnostic Laboratory confirmed the positive.

All evidence and testimony was taken under submission and a decision will follow.

7-18-13² **JOCKEY'S FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Christian Santiago Reyes was cautioned to stay down on his mounts and ride to the finish. Apprentice Ricardo Gonzalez was cautioned to keep his mounts straighter in the stretch drive.

7-18-13³ 3RD RACE TRAINER OBJECTION – NO CHANGE

Trainer W.R. Whitehouse, trainer of 7th place finisher #2 "RULLOKE", lodged an objection alleging interference by #3 "SPARKLE JOEL" (3rd) entering the 3/8 turn. #2's jockey Jesus Velasquez did not lodge a claim of foul. After review, the Stewards could find no interference at any point. No change.

7-18-13⁴ 4th RACE HORSE PASSES

Following the running of the 4th race #3 "RENO LUCKY LADY" went down near the 7/8 pole while walking back to the barn area. After a few minutes Track Veterinarian Audrey Clifton reported the horse had expired.

7-19-13¹ BILLY G. LEWIS RULING (Ref: 7/14/13²)

RULING NO.04

Jockey BILLY G. LEWIS having now appeared at a hearing before the Board of Stewards at the California State Fair (Sacramento) on July 14, 2013; Pacific Racing Association Ruling #14 dated November 4, 2012 is hereby set aside and BILLY G. LEWIS is hereby suspended thru the term of his license (August 31, 2013). Additionally, BILLY G. LEWIS will not be eligible to apply for a license until January 1, 2014 and is fined five hundred dollars (\$500.00*) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) and rule #1890 (a) (Possession of Contraband).

It is ordered that BILLY G. LEWIS enroll in and complete a thirty (30) day in-house rehabilitation program, approved by the Winners Foundation, prior to reinstatement.

BILLY G. LEWIS shall be on a signed testing agreement for the term of all licenses. Prior to reinstatement BILLY G. LEWIS is ordered to appear before the Board of Stewards to review compliance with this ruling.

The above ruling was issued following due deliberation over July 14th's hearing.

7-19-13² **JESUS ARRIAGA RULING**

RULING NO.05

Jockey Jesus Arriaga is hereby fined the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (cases not covered) for giving two (2) calls in one race on Wednesday July 17, 2013 at the California State Fair.

The above ruling was issued when it was discovered Jesus Arriaga, acting as his own agent, gave two calls in a mule race.

7-19-13³ **TATTOOING DELAYED**

1st time starter "KATHY'S REQUEST" trained by Alex Sywak was reported by Identifier/ Tattoer Gary Greiner to match perfectly with the papers. Mr. Greiner was not able to tattoo her without a tranquilizer.

Mr. Sywak will be allowed to run "KATHY's REQUEST" in today's 7th race with the caveat that she remain at Cal-Expo and be tattooed in the morning.

7-19-13⁴ WENCESLAO COMPLAINTS – CASE 13SW0048 & 13SW0049

A hearing was conducted concerning two Banamine overages from the Cal-Expo harness meet. Trainer Sal Wenceslao raced "TRY THIS" on May 3, 2013 and the post race test sample was reported by Ken Maddy Laboratory, U.C. Davis to contain 55.1 ng/ml Flunixin. On May 4, 2013, Mr. Wenceslao raced "JESSALILPEACE" and the post race sample was reported to contain 65.3 ng/ml of Flunixin. Mr. Wenceslao was notified of both findings on May 16, 2013 by Investigator D.A. Tadlock.

Mr. Wenceslao stated that he supervised Owner/Groom/Driver Williams Arriaga administer Banamine paste according to label directions and practicing veterinarian instructions.

Both Bute and Banamine paste have traditionally caused overages for trainers. The reasons vary from slow metabolism, migration of medicine, and/or bad measurement administration.

Decision to follow.

7-19-13⁵ **ROAP STUDENTS**

The Racing Official Accreditation Program (ROAP) has been running classes for potential Stewards from around the country. Ten current Stewards participated in continuing education at U.C. Davis last Monday and Tuesday and today the rest of the potential Stewards in the class came to Cal-Expo. They were treated to talks by State Vet Forrest Franklin, Deputy Chief of Enforcement Dan Dailey and all time leading jockey Russell Baze. During the races small groups visited the Stewards stand to observe and ask questions.

7-19-13⁶ 1ST RACE MULE INQUIRY – NO CHANGE

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign to review the reason for #2 "PRISCILLA NELSON" breaking slowly. After review it was determined that #2 was afforded a fair start.

7-19-13⁷ 6th RACE POST PARADE INCIDENT – TWO LATE SCRATCHES

During the post parade #3 "COME ON DUDE" unseated jockey Kyle Frey and ran off. #3 then ran into #7 "SAILORS BROTHER" knocking Jockey Christian Santiago Reyes off that mount. The Stewards observed the incident and scratched both horses.

DEZOTELL HEARING – CASE 13GG083

A hearing was held today concerning possession of marijuana by Trainer Lisa DeZotell on the grounds of the Alameda County Fair backside.

Ms. DeZotell was present and the case was presented by CHRB Senior Special Investigator Louis Quezada before the full Board of Stewards. Wendy Frazier recorded the proceedings.

A small amount of marijuana (about two joints worth) was confiscated at the barn and DeZotell admitted it was hers. Ms. DeZotell claimed to have been using a medical marijuana card since 2010 but produced a card issued July 13, 2013. The incident at Pleasanton (Alameda) occurred on July 4, 2013. Decision will follow.

7-20-13² WENCESLAO RULING (Red: 7/19/13⁴)

RULING NO.06

Trainer SAL WENCESLAO, who started the horse "TRY THIS" in the seventh race on May 3, 2013 and "JESSALILPEACE" on May 14, 2013 is hereby fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1843 (a) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances – Flunixin) ("TRY THIS" - 55.1 ng/ml) and ("JESSALILPEACE-65.3 ng/ml).

The above ruling was issued after deliberation over yesterday's hearing. Mitigating circumstances considered included Mr. Wenceslao's perfect record of rule compliance and the fact that both high readings occurred before the barn was notified of the first reading.

7-20-13³ MONICA MEDELES-RUIZ RULING (Ref: 7/18/13¹)

RULING NO. 07

Groom MONICA MEDELES-RUIZ having now appeared at a hearing before the Board of Stewards at the California State Fair (Sacramento) on July 18, 2013 California State Exposition & Fair Ruling #1 dated July 14, 2013 is hereby set aside and MONICA MEDELES-RUIZ is hereby suspended forty five (45) days (July 24 thru September 6, 2013 inclusive) and placed on probation for the term of her license for violation of CHRB Rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct- Under Influence of Stimulant).

MONICA MEDELES-RUIZ shall be on a signed testing agreement for the term of all licenses. Prior to reinstatement MONICA MEDELES-RUIZ must submit to an evaluation with the Winners Foundation, abide by any recommendations from that organization acceptable to the Board of Stewards and test clean for chemical substances.

The above ruling was issued after Ms. Medeles-Ruiz was contacted and given the ruling information.

7-20-13⁴ STORTZ & GARCIA ALTERCATION

Jockey's Shyann Garcia and Marcia Stortz were in to explain an altercation in the Jockey's Room yesterday. Both Stortz and Garcia stated that Garcia was the antagonist in the conflict. No specific reason for the blow up was given by either party. Garcia stated she was the aggressor in the incident and would accept the penalty. Thus, the following ruling was generated by the Stewards.

RULING NO.08

Jockey SHYANN GARCIA is hereby fined the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct-Fighting in Jockey's Room) on Friday July 19, 2013 at the California State Fair (Sacramento).

7-20-13⁵ 2ND RACE INQUIRY – DOUBLE OBJECTION (Quarter Horse) – NO CHANGE

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign to review two incidents in this 350 yard Quarter horse race. Jockey Luis Lira aboard #4 "SPARKIN ONE" (2nd) lodged a claim of foul against #5 "FIRST REGAL CHOICE" (1st) and Jockey Jesus Arriaga for alleged interference shortly after the start.

Jockey Luis Langorica aboard #2 "STRAWFLYIN HAWK" (4th) lodged a claim of foul against #3 "Z BEST CONTENDER" (7th). #2 beat #3 so the objection was mute.

The first incident was reviewed by the Stewards and found to be minor in nature. #5 comes in shortly after the start and makes slight contact with #4. No change was warranted.

The second incident was twofold with #3 coming in sharply bumping #2 shortly after the start and then further on in the race #2 comes out bumping #3. The Stewards felt both horses and riders contributed to the incident. No change. Both riders were ordered to visit the Stewards tomorrow.

7-20-13⁶ 3RD RACE MULE – DOUBLE INQUIRY – ONE DISQUALIFICATION

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign to review two incidents in this 400 yard mule event. #4 "RESTLESS HANNA" (Jockey – Jesus Arriaga) reared at the start and was left at the gate. A review confirmed #4 had a fair start and created its own problems. No change.

About half way through the race #5 "JANI NELSON" (3rd – Jockey Francisco Maldonado) steps out into the path of #6 "DASHING JACK" (6th) causing Jockey Luis Lira to check sharply to avoid heels. #5 was disqualified in a unanimous decision from 3rd to 6th place.

7-20-13⁷ **5TH RACE INQUIRY – NO CHANGE**

The inquiry sign was posted to review an incident in the stretch involving 2nd place finisher #4 "STREET ROCKET" (Jockey – Catalino Martinez) and #1 JANERO (Jockey-Russell Baze) who finished 3rd. After review it was determined that #4 crosses over in front of #1 in deep stretch but was barely clear at the time. No change.

7-20-13⁸ 8th RACE – INQUIRY/OBJECTION - DISQUALIFICATION

The inquiry sign was posted to review an incident shortly after the start involving 5th place finisher #7 "FIGHTIN MEAN MAD" (Jockey- Kyle Frey) and 6th place finisher #4 "DISTINCTIVE YOLIE" (Jockey – Russell Baze). Baze also lodged a claim of foul.

Tapes show #7 break alertly from the gate and angle in toward the rail bumping hard with #4 causing jockey Baze to steady his mount. In the unanimous opinion of the Stewards, the blatant foul cost #4 the opportunity of a better placing. #7 was disqualified from 5th to 6th for the infraction. Jockey Frey was ordered to see the Stewards.

OWNER/TRAINER LISA JEAN DEZOTELL is hereby fined the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00)* and placed on probation for the term of her license (10-31-2013) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1489(h) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License- Possession of Marijuana on Backside) on Thursday July 4, 2013 at the Alameda County Fairgrounds (Pleasanton).

LISA JEAN DEZOTELL must submit to an evaluation with the Winner's Foundation and abide by any recommendations from that organization to a Board of Stewards. The terms of probation require that LISA JEAN DEZOTELL must sign a testing agreement with the CHRB.

The above ruling was issued following deliberation over yesterday's hearing. DeZotell has had a clean record with the Board concerning drug use. The ruling places conditions for any future problems.

$7-21-13^2$ LANGORICA RULING (Ref. 7/20/13⁵) - RULING NO.10

RULING NO.10

Jockey LUIS LANGARICA, who rode STRAWFLYIN HAWK in the second race at the California State Fair (Sacramento), Saturday July 20, 2013 is suspended three (3) racing days (July 28, 31 and August 1, 2013) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch. A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The above ruling was issued after Jockey Hugo Herrera appeared on Langorica's behalf. Langorica claimed foul yesterday, but was found guilty of his own infraction in that race.

7-21-13³ MARTIN ARRIAGA RULING

RULING NO.11

Apprentice Jockey MARTIN ARRIAGA, who rode Z BEST CONTENDER in the second race at the California State Fair (Sacramento), Saturday July 20, 2013 is suspended three (3) racing days (July 28, 31 and August 1, 2013) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch. A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The above ruling was issued after Arriaga sent his brother, Juan, to represent him with the Stewards. Young Martin has just recently obtained a license and should have appeared himself for educational purposes. However, the Stewards accept representatives for the penalty phase. Martin's lack of effort led to the ruling.

7-21-13⁴ MARTIN ARRIAGA RULING – NO.12

Apprentice Jockey MARTIN ARRIAGA is hereby fined the sum of fifty (\$50.00)* dollars for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (cases not covered-failure to attend film review) on July 21, 2013.

The above ruling was issued for failure to review films as ordered.

7-21-13⁵ **JOCKEY KYLE FREY RULING**

RULING NO.13

Jockey KYLE FREY, who rode FIGHTIN MEAN MAD in the eighth race at the California State Fair (Sacramento), Saturday July 20, 2013 is suspended five (5) racing days (July 28, 31, August 1, 2 and 3, 2013) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course on the backstretch and causing interference resulting in a disqualification from fifth to sixth. A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Frey appeared and reviewed the films with the Stewards. Frey could give no reasonable explanation for steering his mount toward the inside rail bumping an impeding a rival in the process shortly after the start. The carelessness in this incident led to a five, rather than a three, day sanction.

7-21-13⁶ SHOW WAGERING CANCELLED

Show wagering was cancelled, by management, on today's 1st and 3rd races.

7-21-13⁷ 1ST RACE MULES 350 YARDS – OBJECTION – NO CHANGE

Jockey Francisco Maldonado, aboard 5th place finisher #1 "BLUE MCGEE PHD" lodged a claim of foul against 4th place finisher #2 "BAR JF LOTTO TICKET" and Jockey Hugo Herrera for alleged interference shortly after the start.

After review it was determined that, while tight quarters existed briefly, #1's chances were not compromised as she was hard to manage and beaten well off.
