Jockey JONATHAN ROMAN, who rode OKIE PRIDE LARRY in the first race at the California State Fair (Sacramento) on Friday, July 13, 2012, is suspended seven (7) racing days (July 21, 22, 25, 26, 27, 28 and 29, 2012) for causing interference in the stretch resulting in a disqualification of his mount from fourth to unplaced; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.
