



What does a Physician do?

- Physicians diagnose and treat human illness, disease and injury.
- They perform analysis of patient histories, physical examinations, and interpretations of diagnostic tests.
- · They help patients through life-threatening situations and severe illnesses.
- Physicians use accepted methods of medical treatment, including pharmaceutical agents and surgical procedures.

What kind of education would I need?

- College degree followed by a four-year degree as a doctor of medicine (M.D.) or a doctor of osteopathy (D.O.) from an accredited school
- Pass an examination for state licensure from the Board of Medical Examiners as well as a National Medical Licensure Examination
- At least one year of supervised patient care training, called residency
- Resident needs at least three years of supervision after medical school to be recognized
 in a specialty. An in-depth examination is required at the end of the residency training in
 order to become certified by the board of examiners of the specialty.
