

Highway Improvement



Prior to 2006, there was a high rate of reported cross-over collisions from Toppenish to the Columbia River on State Route 97. To help reduce this problem, the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) constructed a centerline rumble strip.

Since construction, all cross-over collisions have been reduced by 40% and serious injury or fatality collisions have been reduced by 28% annually

SECTOR submitted PTCR






SECTOR - seat position







- SECTOR passenger seating position can be entered two ways. You may either choose from a drop down list or by selecting the ellipse box. Selecting the ellipse box will open a seat position diagram
- From the seat position diagram, you can select the seat position of the passenger by clicking on the seat number
- From the drop down list, if you select left rear passenger in a 5-6 passenger vehicle SECTOR will place them in seat position number 7 putting the passenger in the trunk of the vehicle






Injury classification

Nomenclature and has change for injury coding

- Unknown
- No injury
- Possible injury
- Suspected Minor Injury
- Non-traffic injury
- Suspected Serious injury
- Non-traffic fatality
- Dead at scene
- Dead on arrival
 - Died at hospital






Nature of Injuries


Please include the nature of injuries to the best of your ability:

- 5. Suspected Serious Injury (broken leg) better describes the injury than "leg"
- 7. Possible injury (concussion) better describes the injury than "head"





Conflicting diagram and narrative




On 12-01-2011 at 0900 hrs, a collision occurred at the intersection of Market and Park St.

Simmons, Steve (Unit 01) was stopped in the intersection to make a left turn. Perkins, Tracy (Unit 02) was traveling in the second lane of Market St. facing north. Unit 01 turned left in front of Unit 02 causing Unit 02 to collide into the right side of Unit 01.

The driver of Unit 1 was issued a NOI for failing to yield right of way when turning left.

Conflicting diagram and narrative



Unit 01 was northbound at 25th St. and Puget Ave. The driver Jones, Jane stated she was crossing Puget Ave. when she received a text on her cell phone. Jones stated that she looked down to answer the text and when she glanced up, she saw she was going to strike a tree. Jones struck the tree on the vehicles front passenger side.

Smith's towing arrived and took possession of the vehicle that was not drivable and blocking the roadway.

- This is another example of a diagram and narrative received by WSP Collision Records Section
 - •Are the roadways listed on the diagram?
 - •Which direction was the vehicle travelling?
 - •Unit 01 is not labeled in the diagram
 - •Where is the cross street (Puget Ave.)?

Intersection criteria

- Is the collision:
 - Approximately 25 feet from the intersections stopping point
 - Within a roundabout
 - With a vehicle accessing a primary traffic way using a wye connector
 - Within a turn lane before an intersection



Conflicting diagram and narrative



Unit 1 was northbound at 25th St. and Puget Ave. The driver Smith, Lana stated she was crossing Puget Ave. when she received a text on her cell phone. Smith stated that she looked down to answer the text and when she glanced up, she saw she was going to strike a tree. Smith struck the tree on the vehicles front passenger side.

Pickard's towing arrived and took possession of the vehicle that was not drivable and blocking the roadway.



Nature of injuries

- 1. No injury
- Dead at scene
- 3. Dead on arrival
- 4. Died at hospital
- Suspected Serious injury
- 6. Suspected Non disabling (evident injury)
- 7. Possible injury
- Non traffic injury
- Non traffic fatal








Location, part A and SECTOR




Intersection or non-intersection (if intersection is checked no distance and direction are required).

- Check the box for block number or Mile post
- Distance from secondary street and the compass direct to get to the secondary street (Required if Non Intersection checked).






Roadway types


- 1. One way

Two way-undivided






Two-way divided highways (with barrier)





Two-way divided highways (without barrier)








Commercial vehicle information

When to use the commercial motor carrier portion of the report:

Collisions involving a vehicle with:

- 2 or more axles and 6 tires
- Bus with seating for 16 or more (including driver)
- Any vehicle requiring a hazardous material placard






Incomplete or missing information

DAMAGE THRESHOLD MET

- \$700. damage threshold met?
- Insurance box not checked Insurance box not checked or missing insurance company or policy number
- Incomplete make, year, VIN (vehicle Identification number) or license number
- Incomplete drivers license number or name
- Fire, Stolen, hit and run vehicle box
- Collision with object additional Unit
- Late or missing reports






Attachments






