	Motion to Declare the Defendant Indigent for Costs – submit prior to billing, not at time of billing. Clerk's Application for Indigency – submit prior to billing, not at time of billing. Affidavit Attesting to Attorney's Fees – submit prior to billing, not at time of billing. Order Declaring the Defendant Indigent for Costs – submit prior to billing, not at time of billing. Charging Document(s) <i>if available</i> . IFC Agreement/ Contract (Attorney will execute online).
Additional Required Documents	
	Motion and Order Authorizing Transcription: <u>Must</u> include name(s) of all deponent(s) to be transcribed and <u>must</u> match name(s) of all deponent(s) listed on voucher/invoice. **If expedited rates are billed, the order <u>must</u> specify the authorized rate type (Overnight, 5-day, Regular), otherwise default to standard rates.
Information Required on Voucher/Invoice	
	Attorney name and Bar ID. (If the Defendant is Pro se, then the Defendant's name.) Vendor Name. Payee Tax ID Number. Case number. Defendant name. Service date or Order date. Deponent/Interviewee/Witness name(s). Number of pages billed. Total amount billed. Vendor Signature and Attorney Signature. (If the defendant is Pro se, then the signature of Defendant or Standby Counsel).
