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ETHICAL PRACTICES BOARD ISSUES 1985 STATE OFFICEHOLDERS

CAMPAIGN FINANCE SUMMARY

Individuals, political committees and funds, and political parties contributed \$1,740,147 to campaign committees of state officeholders in 1985, a nonelection year, according to a summary of campaign reports compiled by the Ethical Practices Board.

The summary includes reports of receipts and expenditures by the principal campaign committees of the governor, lieutenant governor, attorney general, secretary of state, state auditor, state treasurer, and senators and representatives in the state legislature.

State executive officeholders received total contributions of \$630,179 in 1985, including \$421,530 from 396 contributions in amounts over \$200 (67% of contributions received). State legislators received total contributions of \$1,109,968 with 21% received from 1,079 contributions in amounts over \$100.

State officeholders reported making total campaign expenditures of \$408,851 in nonelection year 1985. All state executive and legislative offices will be up for election in 1986. State senators reported total campaign expenditures of \$129,789 in 1985, a 97% increase over the \$69,840 campaign expenditures reported for 1984, a nonelection year for state senators. State representatives reported total campaign expenditures of \$159,310 in 1985, an 89% increase over \$84,460 in 1983.

Beginning cash balances, January 1, 1985, reported by state officeholders totaled \$737,635, with total ending cash balances of \$1,468,002 on December 31, 1985. State representatives ended nonelection year 1985 with total cash balances of \$406,895, compared with \$309,997 at the end of nonelection year 1983. State senators ended 1985 with total cash balances of \$553,268, compared with \$286,519 at the end of 1984, and \$226,112 at the end of 1983.

The Board's summary includes, for each officeholder's committee, total contributions received; total transfers to other candidates and committees; total campaign expenditures; beginning and ending cash balances; and a listing of the names of

individuals, committees, or funds contributing, in aggregate during 1985, more than \$100 to state legislators and more than \$200 to state executive officeholders.

Campaign reports of state officeholders are available for public inspection at the Board office, 625 North Robert Street, St. Paul. Copies of legislators' reports are available, also, in the county auditor's office in each county in the legislators' districts.

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An analysis of reports filed by principal campaign committees of state officeholders for nonelection years 1985, 1983, and 1981 is attached, with Election '86 reporting dates, campaign finance program.

ABOUT THIS SUMMARY

Reported in this summary are the total amount of cash on hand January 1, 1985, campaign contributions received, expenditures made in 1985, and cash on hand December 31, 1985, for principal campaign committees of state officeholders* in 1985.

Campaign expenditure limit (\$254,160 governor-lieutenant governor; \$42,360 attorney general; \$21,180 secretary of state, state auditor, state treasurer; \$6,354 state senator; \$3,355 state representative) is in effect only for those candidates who signed a public financing agreement or tax credit agreement or both.

Major donors listed are those contributing in aggregate in 1985 more than \$100 (to legislative, district, and county court candidates) or more than \$200 (to statewide candidates). Only those officeholders receiving these amounts are listed in the major donor section of this summary.

ABOUT CANDIDATE CAMPAIGN FINANCE DISCLOSURE

A candidate for state executive, legislative, or judicial office who accepts more than \$100 from sources other than the candidate's own personal funds is required to register a principal campaign committee with the Ethical Practices Board. However, a candidate who does not designate and form a principal campaign committee and who spends more than \$100 of the candidate's own money, not including filing fee, to influence that candidate's nomination or election is required to file a Report of Receipts and Expenditures with the Board.

ABOUT THIS SUMMARY

**ETHICAL PRACTICES BOARD ISSUES 1985 POLITICAL COMMITTEE
AND FUND CAMPAIGN FINANCE SUMMARY**

A record \$8.11 million in contributions was received by 653 political committees and political funds in 1985, a nonelection year, according to a summary of campaign reports compiled by the Ethical Practices Board. This represents a 26% increase over nonelection year 1983, when \$6.46 million was received, and a 36% increase over the \$5.97 million received in 1981.

Included in the \$8.11 million total are contributions of \$4,628,980 received by 354 political committees and funds other than political party units. All but 8% of the total was received in amounts of \$200 and less. Separate donations over \$200 were received from 689 donors, totaling \$378,291.

Treasurers of 653 political committees and funds were required to file with the Board a report of receipts and expenditures covering January 1 through December 31, 1985. Included in this number are reports by 299 committees of the Democratic-Farmer-Labor, Independent-Republican, and other political parties as well as 354 committees and funds established by associations in order to contribute either to candidates for state offices or to support or oppose state constitutional amendments, or both.

Political party committees received a total of \$3,479,843 in contributions during 1985. Approximately one-fifth of these contributions was received as separate donations of more than \$200 from 994 contributors, totaling \$771,614.

According to statistics compiled from campaign finance reports filed for 1985, 118 labor-oriented committees and funds (including education-related) received 99% of their \$2,183,069 total contributions in amounts of \$200 or less. In the issue-oriented category, 113 committees and funds (including membership associations) received total contributions of \$1,609,537, with 10% received as separate donations

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of more than \$200 from 343 contributors. In the remaining category, 123 business-oriented committees and funds (including trade, professional, and health-related) received 24% of their \$836,374 total contributions as separate donations of more than \$200 from 330 contributors.

In nonelection year 1985, the 653 political committees and funds reporting to the Board contributed \$2,388,035 to influence state election campaigns. This represents a 170% increase from 1983, another nonelection year, when \$882,792 was contributed by 632 political committees and funds and a 99% increase from the \$1,183,543 contributed in 1981 by 548 political committees and funds.

The Board's 1985 summary includes, for each political committee and political fund, total contributions received; total contributions to candidates and other committees; beginning and ending cash balances; and a listing of the names of individuals and committees or funds contributing, in aggregate during 1985, more than \$200.

Campaign finance reports of candidate and officeholder principal campaign committees, political committees, and political funds are available for public inspection in the Board office, 625 North Robert Street, St. Paul. Copies of legislators' reports are available, also, in the county auditor's office in each county in the legislators' districts.
