UPON FURTHER REVIEW

PER CURIAM:

This case is before us on its merits for further review. In *United States v. Grover*, 63 M.J. 653 (A.F. Ct. Crim. App. 2006), this Court affirmed the appellant's conviction, but set aside the sentence and returned the record of trial to The Judge Advocate General for remand to the convening authority. After a rehearing on the sentence, a court-martial composed of officer members sentenced the appellant to confinement for 9 months and reduction to the grade of E-1. The convening authority approved the sentence as adjudged.

Upon further review, the approved findings and sentence are correct in law and fact, and no error prejudicial to the substantial rights of the appellant occurred. Article 66(c), UCMJ, 10 U.S.C. § 866(c); *United States v. Reed*, 54 M.J. 37, 41 (C.A.A.F. 2000). Accordingly, the approved findings and sentence are

AFFIRMED.
