PER CURIAM:

This case is before our Court for further review because the original action was set aside. *United States v. Gutierrez*, \_\_\_\_\_M.J. \_\_\_, ACM 35661 (A.F. Ct. Crim. App. 19 Dec 2005). This court returned the case to The Judge Advocate General for remand to the convening authority for new post-trial processing because the original staff judge advocate's recommendation (SJAR) failed to provide the convening authority with information he had requested. On 1 February 2006, a new SJAR was completed.
