PER CURIAM:

This case is before our Court for further review because the original action was set aside. *United States v. Lajaunie*, 60 M.J. 280 (C.A.A.F. 2004) (mem.). Our superior court returned the case to The Judge Advocate General for remand to the convening authority for a new action in light of its decision in *United States v. Emminizer*, 56 M.J. 441 (C.A.A.F. 2002). On 22 September 2004, the convening authority completed a new action to comply with *Emminizer*.
