PER CURIAM:

This case is before our Court for further review because the original action was set aside. *United States v. Newhouse*, ACM S30325 (A.F. Ct. Crim. App. 18 Apr 2005) (unpub. op.). This court returned the case to The Judge Advocate General for remand to the convening authority for a new action to reflect the pretrial confinement credit awarded the appellant by the military judge. On 2 May 2005, the convening authority completed a new action to comply with our holding.

Apart from the speedy trial issue raised with us originally, the appellant submitted the record and new action for further review on its merits. The approved findings and sentence are correct in law and fact, and no error prejudicial to the substantial rights of the appellant occurred.
