WHY THE NAME SILVER JACKETS?

Traditionally, different agencies wear different colored jackets when responding to emergencies. For example, FEMA personnel wear blue and USACE personnel wear red. The name Silver Jackets (SJ) is used to underscore the common mission of the diverse agencies involved.

FLOOD FACTS

Flooding is the most dangerous natural disaster

- From 2008 to 2012 flood related insurance claims in the United States averaged nearly \$4 billion per year.
- Flood risk is the #1 threat in the Nebraska All Hazards Mitigation Plan
- Homeowners insurance does not cover flood damage

Flooding can impact anyone

25% of flood insurance claims come from outside of recognized flood hazard areas

Your flood risk is unique to you and your family. This is because of the various types of flood threats, and the unique consequences your family would face

- Flooding can be associated with spring thaw, heavy rains, dams, or levees.
- Your unique consequences can include medical, personal information, pets, and emotional strain on top of financial loss.

The Silver Jackets Risk Communication web-tool is built to assist you and your family to prepare for and survive flood threats.

MANAGING FLOOD RISK

Flood damage to property has an enormous financial and health impact on people.

The authorities and objectives of flood risk management reside in the hands of multiple local, state, and federal agencies. The Nebraska Silver Jackets bring together information from multiple agencies to assist homeowners in recognizing and responding to their flood risk.
