
Addition of all Safety Education & Outreach Programs

- During the planning phase of this project, it was determined that it would be best to incorporate other educational offerings into the system being planned and designed for Hunter Education.
- The scope of the original Hunter Education Project has been expanded to support all of the bureau's education programs.



Project Goal

This project will increase public access to safety education opportunities, improve registration services for students and volunteer instructors, and streamline data management processes.

- The purpose of this project is to increase public access to safety education opportunities via the web.

- Latest course information
- User friendly registration

- Solid platform for lifetime of licensing requirements and recreation opportunities
- Effectively capture data for federal retention and reporting requirements
- Support of \$400 million economic resource for Iowa from hunting alone



Request

- \$50,000 for the design phase of this project.
 - Cost for ITE to transfer mainframe data to new database
 - Cost associated with gathering ELSI data and populating their system
 - Completing mock-up screens
 - Report Definition Documents
 - Preparation of the implementation funding request

- Automatic notification system for students and instructors
- Obtain online training data from outside vendors
- Create system messages
- Online registration
- Scheduled uploads of certification data to ELSI
- Long-term data retention cycle
- Link to International Hunter Education Portal
