CONTINUING EDUCATION

All auctioneers, apprentice auctioneers, and designated person(s) of an auction firm must have 4 hours of continuing education credit in order to renew their licenses. The new fiscal year starts on July 1, 2010 and ends on June 30, 2011. These 4 hours of continuing education must be in the NCALB office by **May 15, 2010**. You may fax (919-567-2865) or email (info@ncalb.org) your CE hours. Renewal applications will be mailed to those who have satisfied the continuing education requirement toward the end of May.
