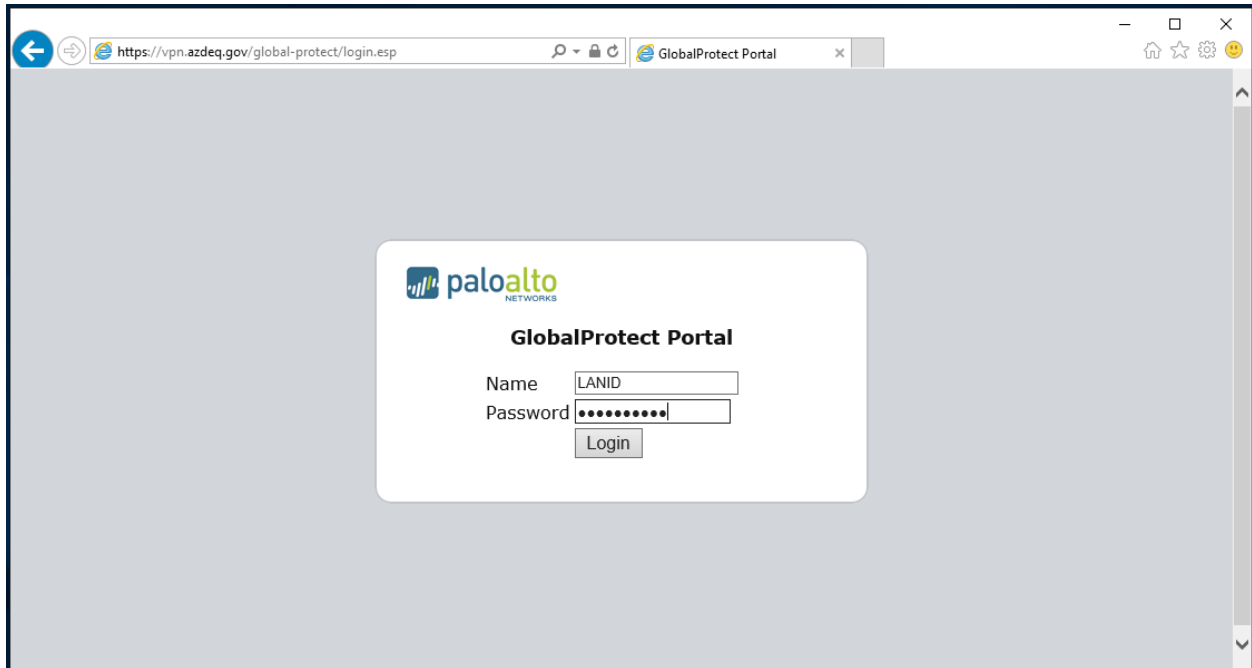


GlobalProtect VPN Installation Instructions

1. Browse to <https://vpn.azdeq.gov> and enter you LANID and password



2. Click the link that corresponds to your installed operating system and click **Run**.

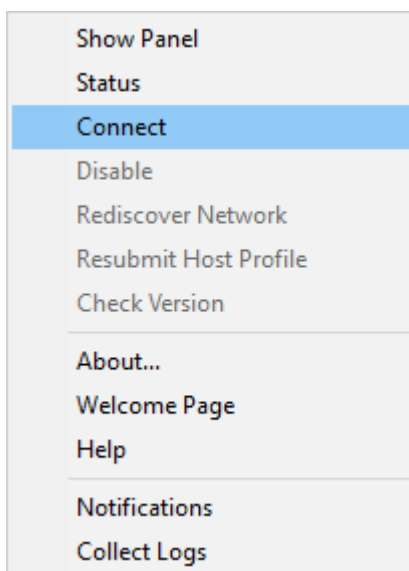





The following icon will appear in the system tray.

Enter login information and click connect.



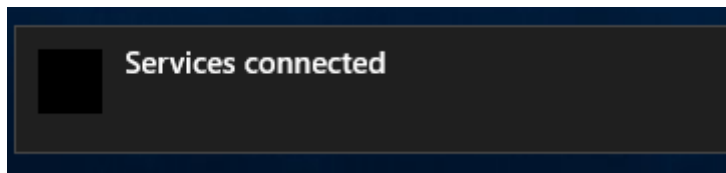
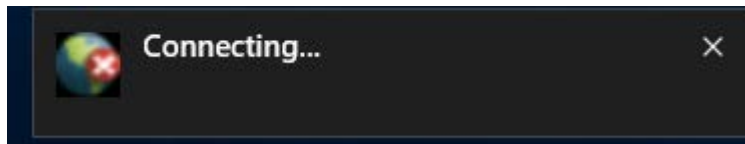
