

- ◆ B14 CROSSOVER COLLISIONS: In the past week there have been two traffic collisions at the Katterbach/Bismarck crossover point of Highway B14. Both traffic collisions were the result of vehicles entering the intersection in possible violation of a red light traffic signal while traveling east on B14 toward Nürnberg, subsequently colliding with vehicles that were signaled to cross between Katterbach and Bismarck Kasernes. Defensive driving habits could help prevent future accidents. Vehicle operators entering the crossover from any direction must maintain vigilance of other vehicles and pedestrians and must obey traffic signals. - ◆ **Bad Windsheimer Kirchweih** - The Bad Windsheim Kirchweih on Aug. 19 through 30 is a traditional Kirchweih Volksfest with rides, fest tent, parade and fireworks. To learn more, go to www.tourismus.bad-windsheim.de
- ◆ **Herbstvolksfest – Nürnberg** - The Nürnberg Fall Fest is one of the largest and nicest fests in Bavaria; visitors will find plenty of fun rides, beer tents and food stands, as well as an entertainment program for everybody. The fest from August 28 to September 11 is located on the Dutzendteich (Bayernstrasse). Details are available at www.volksfest-nuernberg.de
- ◆ **State Garden Show in Bayreuth** - Every year the state of Bavaria hosts a garden show in a different location; landscapes are transformed into beautiful garden scenes, attracting hundreds of thousands of visitors every year. This year the "Landesgartenschau" is located in Bayreuth, capital of Upper Franconia. The show is open daily 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. until October 9 along the Roter Main River (Friedrich-Ebert-Straße/Äußere Badstraße). Day tickets are available for 16 euros for adults, an annual pass is 100 euros; children 7-17 years old pay 3 euros per day or 25 for the annual pass. Visitors arriving by train at the Bayreuth Bahnhof can use a free shuttle to the location and will receive a 2 euro discount on their (adult's) ticket by showing the train pass. - ◆ **Reichsstadt-Festtage – Rothenburg** - The Reichsstadt-Festtage or Imperial Days in Rothenburg ob der Tauber on Sept. 2 through 4 celebrate the history of the old Imperial city. 
